Situated in a rustic setting with its own private lake, the camp can accommodate up to 45 campers in 7 cabins. Each cabin during the junior camps has a trained Cabin Leader in with them. In addition to the campers' cabins there is a large meeting hall, dining hall, hospital, outdoor chapel, and leaders' cabins. The camp has modern washhouse facilities. A certified lifeguard and spotters always supervise the beach area. The camp has some watercraft available for campers.
