

Event Attendance Requirements and Registration Fees Refund Policies

Ajapeu Lodge 2 is committed to following Scouting America's policies and Washington Crossing Council's additional directives for the health, safety, and well-being of its members, as well as being fiscally responsible with the management of its finances. As a result, the following event attendance requirements and registration fee refund policies are in effect.

To attend Ajapeu Lodge 2 Order of the Arrow (OA) events, all participants must register for the event and pay its registration fees, as applicable. Excluding registered guests (when permitted), all participants must be registered in Scouting America, have current Youth Protection Training (if 18 or older), and either be a Brother in Ajapeu Lodge 2 who has paid this year's dues or, for Induction events, be an eligible OA Candidate as per the current requirements specified by the National Order of the Arrow Committee*.

Unless the Ajapeu Lodge 2 event is canceled, its registration fees are non-refundable. However, if the Lodge Adviser is notified via email at adviser@ajapeu2.org before the registration for the event is closed, registration fees for an Ajapeu Lodge 2 event may be transferred for the same registrant to another Ajapeu Lodge 2 event within the same calendar year if one exists. Registration fees will not be refunded or transferred for Ajapeu Lodge 2 event registrants who do not meet event attendance requirements.

Additional attendance requirements and refund policies may exist and be separately specified for non Ajapeu Lodge 2 or other special events, including Section, Region, and National OA events.

By registering for the event, participants acknowledge and accept the event attendance requirements and registration fees refund policies.

* As per the Membership Information on the National OA website (https://oa-scouting.org/), OA Candidates currently have 18 months from the date of their election (or their nomination approval in the case of Adults 21 or older) to complete their Induction ceremony.
