Honor Pledge Committee

WHEREAS, SGA members have developed an Honor Pledge for Samford University, and

WHEREAS, both the SGA and Faculty Senate officially support the further development and implementation of this Honor Pledge, and

WHEREAS, this Honor Pledge will encourage Samford students to commit to a high standard of integrity and excellence in all areas of life, and

WHEREAS, an ad hoc committee is now needed to implement the Honor Pledge, and

WHEREAS, Article 306.10 of the Code of Laws requires that all ad hoc committees be proposed by a resolution in the Senate,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT SENATE OF SAMFORD

UNIVERSITY, that an ad hoc committee be created for the purpose of implementing the Honor Pledge under the following parameters, pursuant to Article 306.10 of the Code of Laws.

1. The purpose of the Honor Pledge committee shall be to write the Samford University Honor Pledge, educate the undergraduate student body concerning the pledge, and work to have the pledge officially adopted by the university.

During the Fall 2016 semester, the committee will prepare a presentation concerning the pledge, give the presentation to various student groups across campus, and receive feedback concerning the pledge from those groups. If the feedback is consistently negative, the committee might end the project. If the feedback is positive, the committee will continue the project.

During the Spring 2017 semester, the committee may continue giving presentations and receiving feedback. Primarily, however, it will focus on having the Honor Pledge officially adopted by the university. This will require faculty approval, administrative approval, a vote by the student body in the spring elections, and perhaps approval by the board of trustees. If the approval process goes well, we will work with SJC to train them to continue peer education concerning the Honor Pledge when this committee is dissolved.


2. The committee will exist for one academic year (2016-2017).


3. The committee will meet bi-weekly.


