Campus Recycling Resolution

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Student Government Association Senate to exercise oversight on all matters of student opinion and concern, and

WHEREAS, it is the duty and calling of Samford University as a Christian University to steward the environment and live sustainably, and

WHEREAS, Samford university does not have recycling bins at all of its major waste disposal areas, and

WHEREAS, placing recycling bins where large dumpsters are already and smaller bins in high traffic areas would make it easier to recycle and promote environmental stewardship on campus,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT SENATE OF SAMFORD UNIVERSITY,

Section 1: Samford University places (paper and plastic) recycling dumpsters adjacent to trash dumpsters that are currently in West Campus, West Village, and Beeson Woods.

Section 2: Samford University places small recycling bins/cans, similar to those currently in use in Ben Brown and Beeson Woods, on the plaza at the south side of Vail Hall, at the entrance of the College of Health Sciences, as well as at additional locations that Amber Kustos, the head of environmental stewardship, and other campus administrators see fit.
