



LEADERSHIP AND GROWTH RESPONSIBILITIES: LEGISLATIVE & JUDICIAL BRANCH ROLES

Constitution Court, Senate, ACFC, DFC, PFC, EMU Board

Associate Justice – Constitution Court

PRINCIPLE FUNCTIONS: LEADERSHIP AND GROWTH RESPONSIBILITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THIS POSITION

The individual in this role will:

- Report to Chief Justice of Constitution Court.
- Exercise civility and respect in all matters of the Court. Conduct yourself with the professional demeanor, respect, and decorum as befits a judicial body.
- Examine matters using research and resources available to the court and critically apply knowledge in order to make informed, fact-driven decisions. Recuse yourself during circumstances that may involve self-interest, bias, or prejudice, as outlined in bylaws.
- Uphold and respect the governing documents (Green Tape Notebook) and the three-branch structure of the ASUO. Communicate and relay information to ASUO Senate and ASUO Executive as appropriate.
- Attend meetings and fulfill all position responsibilities as outlined in bylaws.

Senator – Academic

PRINCIPLE FUNCTIONS: LEADERSHIP AND GROWTH RESPONSIBILITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THIS POSITION

The individual in this role will:

- Report jointly to Senate President and Academic Chair.
- Ensure that ASUO Senate and related activity/events encourage and value UO student body input.
- Serve as a liaison to the academic constituencies of your elected seat, representing these populations during discussion, debate and voting. Serve as a tag for programs related to the fields of study you represent.
- Serve on at least two student/faculty committees during the individual's term of office.
- Serve on two internal committees at all times, one of which is the Academic Committee.
- Uphold and respect the governing documents (Green Tape Notebook) and the three-branch structure of the ASUO. Communicate and relay information to the ASUO Executive and Constitution Court as appropriate.
- Strive to ensure that all decisions, financial in particular, are not tied to viewpoint.
- Uphold the principals of fiscal stewardship by ensuring organizational funds are aligned with the organization's goals and spent in accordance with the organization's ASUO-approved budget.
- Uphold Incidental fee (I-fee) spending parameters and the ASUO Mission by verifying the alignment of expenditures with the cultural or physical development of students.
- Fulfill all position responsibilities outlined in bylaws, during the term of office as outlined in bylaws, including but not limited to: attendance at required trainings, weekly office hours, and attendance at meetings.

Senator – Financial

PRINCIPLE FUNCTIONS: LEADERSHIP AND GROWTH RESPONSIBILITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THIS POSITION

The individual in this role will:

- Report jointly to Senate President and respective Finance Committee Chair.
- Ensure that ASUO Senate and related activity/events encourage and value UO student body input.
- Serve on the ASUO Finance Committee to which you were elected.
- Serve on at least one internal committee at all times.
- Uphold and respect the governing documents (Green Tape Notebook) and the three-branch structure of the ASUO. Communicate and relay information to the ASUO Executive and Constitution Court as appropriate.
- Strive to ensure that all decisions, financial in particular, are not tied to viewpoint.
- Uphold the principals of fiscal stewardship by ensuring organizational funds are aligned with the organization's goals and spent in accordance with the organization's ASUO-approved budget.
- Uphold Incidental fee (I-fee) spending parameters and the ASUO Mission by verifying the alignment of expenditures with the cultural or physical development of students.
- Fulfill all position responsibilities outlined in bylaws, during the term of office as outlined in bylaws, including but not limited to: attendance at required trainings, weekly office hours as both a Senator and Finance Committee Member, and attendance at meetings.

Senator – First Year Student Representative (Appointed Role)

PRINCIPLE FUNCTIONS: LEADERSHIP AND GROWTH RESPONSIBILITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THIS POSITION

The individual in this role will:

- Report to Senate President.
- Serve as a non-voting member of Senate.
- Ensure that ASUO Senate and related activity/events encourage and value UO student body input.
- Serve as a liaison to the first-year/freshman population, representing this population during discussion and debate.
- Serve on at least one internal committee at all times.
- Uphold and respect the governing documents (Green Tape Notebook) and the three-branch structure of the ASUO. Communicate and relay information to the ASUO Executive and Constitution Court as appropriate.
- Strive to ensure that all decisions, financial in particular, are not tied to viewpoint.
- Uphold the principals of fiscal stewardship by ensuring organizational funds are aligned with the organization's goals and spent in accordance with the organization's ASUO-approved budget.
- Uphold Incidental fee (I-fee) spending parameters and the ASUO Mission by verifying the alignment of expenditures with the cultural or physical development of students.
- Fulfill all position responsibilities outlined in bylaws, during the term of office as outlined in bylaws, including but not limited to: attendance at required trainings, weekly office hours, and attendance at meetings.

Finance Committee Member – At Large & Executive Designee

PRINCIPLE FUNCTIONS: LEADERSHIP AND GROWTH RESPONSIBILITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THIS POSITION

The individual in this role will:

- Report to Committee Chair.
- Ensure that Committee activity encourages and values UO student body input.
- Serve as a liaison (tag) for certain groups, departments or service providers as assigned by Committee Chair. Relay information to and from the tag group(s) which you are assigned.
- Uphold and respect the governing documents (Green Tape Notebook and Committee bylaws) of the ASUO. Communicate and relay information to the ASUO Senate as appropriate.
- Strive to ensure that all decisions, financial in particular, are not tied to viewpoint.

- Uphold the principals of fiscal stewardship by ensuring organizational funds are aligned with the organization's goals and spent in accordance with the organization's ASUO-approved budget.
