Graduation Scholarships for Seniors was discussed. Since funds are available, Bree made a motion to increase the scholarship to \$150 for a Visa gift card or alternate Walmart gift card for each JOM eligible graduating Woodland Senior. Michelle

Honor Roll incentives were discussed. A motion was made by Bree to provide a \$25 Walmart Card for eligible Woodland JOM students in 1<sup>st</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade who are listed on either the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> 9 weeks in the Fall or 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> 9 weeks in the Spring, receiving only 1 award each semester. Second by Michelle. Motion passed. The gift cards will be presented at an upcoming JOM Meeting. Parents and students will sign off on the receipt of the card.

Request for Funds forms were completed and given to Avis. Upcoming events were discussed. Sovereignty Day Pow Wow March 14<sup>th</sup> and the Osage JOM Youth Pow Wow to be announced.

The next meeting was discussed and is scheduled for February 12<sup>th</sup> at 6 PM at the ON Senior Center.

A motion was made by Bree Lockett to adjourn. The second was made by Michelle McConnell. Motion passed. Meeting was adjourned at 7:16 PM.
