IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE OSAGE NATION

Order Establishing Grounds for Recall of Judicial Officers

Pursuant to Article XI Section 8 of the Constitution of the Osage Nation the following are hereby established as Grounds for Recall of Judicial Officers of the Osage Nation:

- §1. Violation of the Oath of Office found in Article IX of the Constitution of the Osage Nation;
- §2. Violation of the Code of Ethics found in Article X of the Constitution of the Osage Nation;
- §3. Violation of the Inalienable Rights of persons as listed in Article IV Section 3 of the Constitution of the Osage Nation not redressable in the ordinary course of law;
- §4. Willful neglect of duty;
- §5. Malfeasance in office;
- §6. Habitual abuse of alcohol or drugs;
- §7. Conviction of a felony;
- §8. Conviction of a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude;
- §9. Willful violation of the Canons of Judicial Ethics promulgated by the American Bar Association.
