## Training Requirements

There are two 24-month periods in the current training cycle which ends on August 31, 2021.

The first 24-month period, or unit, begins on 09/01/2017 and ends on 08/31/2019. The second 24-month period, or unit, begins on 09/01/2019 and ends on 08/31/2021, which is also the conclusion date of the 48-month training cycle.

### Peace Officer Licensees

#### Training Mandates


Please pay close attention to the training mandates for the 2017-2019 training unit. The number of required hours has not changed.

Required Hours (Texas Occupations Code 1701.351(a)):

2017 to 2019 training unit - 40 hours



2019 to 2021 training unit - 40 hours

Required Courses (Texas Occupations Code 1701.258 (a), 1701.351(a-1) and 1701.352)

2017 to 2019 training unit - Course 3185 State and Federal Law Update  Course (or TCOLE online equivalent).


2019 to 2021 training unit - Course 3186 State and Federal Law Update Course (or TCOLE online equivalent).

4 Year Training Cycle 2017 to 2021

Those holding a BASIC PEACE OFFICER Certificate  or no certificate will be required to have Cultural Diversity,  Special Investigative Topics, and Crisis Intervention Training.

Those holding an INTERMEDIATE or higher do not have specific courses (other than the State and Federal Law Update Course)

**-- Non-Appointed Officers:** training will only be accepted from **TCOLE Contracted Training Providers** --

Course 3270 Human Trafficking  - Must be completed within 1 year of licensing date for those licensed on or after January 1, 2011. Texas Occupations Code 1701.258.

Course 4065 Canine Encounters - Must be completed within 2 years of licensing date for those licensed on or after January 1, 2016. Texas Occupations Code 1701.261.

Course 7887 Interacting with Drivers who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing - Must be completed within 2 years of licensing date for those licensed on or after March 1, 2016. Texas Occupations Code

1701.253, Subsection (1).

## Telecommunicators Training Mandates

Required Courses (Texas Occupations Code 1701.352 (i)):

Beginning September 1, 2015, each licensed telecommunicator must complete no less than 20 hours of training each 2 year training unit.

## Chief Administrators Training Mandates

### Police Chiefs

Each chief must complete at least 40 hours of continuing education through the Bill Blackwood Institute during the current 2 year training unit. (Education Code 96.641)

Chiefs, newly appointed or elected for the first time, are required to complete course 3780 New Chief's Education no later than the second anniversary date of appointment or election. (Education Code 96.641(h)).

Chiefs who have already completed the requirements of a newly elected or appointed chief,

must complete course 3740, Chief's Continuing Education each unit.

## Constables

Each constable must complete at least 40 hours of continuing education through the Bill Blackwood Institute during the current 4 year training cycle. (Occupation Code 1701.3545)

Newly elected or appointed Constables must take Course 3742 New Constable's Course within 2 years of appointment or election. (Occupation Code 1701.3545(d))

Constables who have already completed the requirements of a newly elected or appointed Constables must take Course 3743, Constable's Continuing Education each cycle. (Occupation Code 1701.3545(d))







## **TCOLE Licensee Training Mandates (09/01/2017- 08/31/2021)**

### **Peace Officers (General):**

Training Unit- each 2yr Unit (09/01/17- 08/31/19, 09/01/19- 08/31/21), Peace Officers must take:

- The current Legislative Update (First Unit-3185, Second Unit-3186)(Rule 218.3(a))
- 40hrs, including the above 3185/6 course (Rule 218.3(a))

Training Cycle- each 4yr Cycle (current 09/01/17- 08/31/21), the Peace Officer must take:

- If the Peace Officer has Intermediate Certification or higher- no Cycle requirements
- If the Peace Officer does not achieve Intermediate Certification before the end of the

Cycle- Cultural Diversity (3939), Crisis Intervention Training (3841), Special Investigative Topics (3232), De-escalation (1849) (Rule 218.3(d))

Miscellaneous

- Peace Officers first licensed after 01/01/2011, must take Human Trafficking (3270) within 1 year after initial licensing (Rule 218.3(f))
- Peace Officers first licensed after 01/01/16, must take Canine Encounters (4065) within 2 years of initial licensing (Occupations Code 1701.253(l), 1701.261), if not taken in BPOC.
- Peace Officers first licensed after 03/0/16, must take Deaf and Hard of Hearing Drivers (7887) within 2 years of licensing (Occupations Code 1710.253(l)), if not taken in BPOC.
- Peace Officers licensed before 01/01/18, must take Civilian Interaction Training (course number not yet issued) by 01/01/20. All others within 2 years of initial licensing, if not taken in BPOC. NO EXEMPTIONS (Occupations Code 1701.253n).
- Peace Officers using Body Worn Cameras must take the Body Worn Camera course (8158) before using the cameras (1701.656), if not taken in BPOC.
- Peace Officers appointed to court security at ANY level of court, must take the Court Security course (10999) within 1 year of assignment to that duty. No one is required to take the course before 09/01/19 (Government Code 158.002).
- Peace Officers performing the function of eyewitness identification, as designated by their agency, must first complete the Eyewitness Identification course (3286), beginning 01/01/18 (CCP 2.1386(c)).

### **Peace Officer (Specialized):**

Constables (note- this mandate overrides all of the above, except Body Worn Cameras):

- Must take the New Constable Training (3742) within 2 years of being appointed (Rule 218.3(g)).
- Must take the Constable's Continuing Education (3743) each Cycle, thereafter (Rule 218.3(g))

Deputy Constables:

- In addition to all of the Peace Officer (General) requirements, above, must take Civil Process (3101) each Cycle (Rule 218.3(h))

Police Chiefs (note- this mandate overrides all of the above, except Body Worn Cameras and Civilian Interaction Trng.)

- Must take New Chief's Training (3780) within 2 years of appointment (Rule 218.3(i)).
- Must take Chief's Continuing Education (3740) each Unit, thereafter (Rule 218.3(i)).

### **Jailers/Reserve Peace Officer Licensees/Public Security Officers:**

Training Unit- no requirements

Training Cycle- must take Cultural Diversity (3939), unless exempted by Certification level in another license (Rule 218.3(e))

Miscellaneous

- All current Jailers must take the Mental Health course (4900) by 08/31/21, if not taken in the BCOC (Occupations Code 1701.310a).
- All NEW Jail Administrators must pass the TCJS/TCOLE Jail Administrator course on the TCOLE website within 180 days of assignment as administrator, beginning 03/01/2018 (Gov't Code 511.00905).

### **Telecommunicators**

Training Unit- 20hrs (Rule 218.3(c))

Training Cycle- no requirements
