

### Scriptures that teach an unlimited atonement

Isa. 45:22 "Look unto me, and be ye saved, all ye from the ends of the earth...."

Isa55:1 "Ho! everyone that thirsteth, come ye to the waters....."

Matt: 22:9 " Go ye therefore into the highways, and as many as ye shall find, bid to the marriage."

John 7:37 "...if any man thirst, let him come unto me and drink."

Rom. 10:12 "For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek; for the same Lord over all, is rich unto all that call unto him."

John 3:15,16,17,18. "That whosoever believeth in him should not perish.....that whosoever believeth in him.....believeth not, condemned.....that the world might be saved. V. 18 Believers not condemned, unbelievers condemned already.

Luke 8:12 "...The devil taketh the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved." John 1:17"...that all men through him might believe.

John1:11 Shows men reject him. "...his own received him not."

John 1:12 " But as many as received him, to them he gave the power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name."

John 6:35 " He that cometh to me shall never hunger and he that believeth on me shall never thirst."

John 3:36 "...believeth not on the son, shall not see life."

~~1-Tim 2:4 "Who will have all men to be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth."~~

John 1:7 "John... that all men through him might believe."

John 1:11 Rejected "his own people he did not"

John 1:12 "But to as many as received him, to them gave he power to
