

EL SHADDAI

INTERDUCTION

1. EL SHADDAI is Hebrew for GOD ALMIGHTY.
2. The lesson before us should assure us, if it is of his will it is possible.
3. We would never limit God, if we could get this message and believe it.

I. EL SHADDAI CREATED THE UNIVERSE.

1. Our solar system.
 - A. The sun and nine planets.
 - B. Over sixty moons turning on their axis while orbiting seven of the planets.
 - C. The nine planets turn on their axis while orbiting the sun.
 - D. The sun turns on it's axis while it makes an orbit by twelve constellations of stars, taking with it our entire solar system.
 - E. Gen 1:14 And God said, let there be lights in the firament of the heaven to divide the day from the night, and let them be for signs and for seasons and for days and years
 - F. Our solar system and the twelve constellation of stars are only a small part of a galaxy of stars called the Milky Way.
2. A galaxy is a mass of stars (SUNS), hundreds of millions of them, all interacting and orbiting around a common center.
3. Astronomers estimate, there are a hundred twenty five billion galaxies.
3. Astronomers have discovered sixteen solar systems other than our own, there may be a trillion out there.
4. Ps 19:1 The heavens declare the glory of God, and the firmament sheweth his handiwork.
5. El SHADDAI is heard in every language. Ps 19:3 There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard.

II. EL SHADDAI CREATED ADAM AND EVE

1. God made Adam from the dust of the earth, he was only flesh, the flesh was from dust only. Gen2:7
2. God breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and he became a living

soul (Living being). Gen 2:7

3. The breath of life was spirit, it came from god. Eccl 12:7
4. Life came from the spirit given Adam. James 2:26
5. Adam was created a two fold being, no third part, but there was a third thing called life, when life cease the body goes back to dust, the spirit goes back to God who gave it. Eccl 12:7
6. The Hebrew word, nephesh is translated soul over four hundred times And translated life about one hundred times.
7. The Greek word psuche is translated soul over fifty times and is also translated life over forty times.
8. Use the word life for soul in scriptures like Mat 22:37, I These 5:23, Heb 4:12 and you will understand them.
9. God put Adam to sleep, took a rib from his side and made Eve, when he awoke and saw her, in praise he must have said, EL SHADDAI.
10. God has created the human race, he designed us all and put it in the book of members. Ps 139:16 Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect, and in thy book all my members were written, which in continuance were fashioned, when as yet there was none of them

III. EL SHADDAI CAN SOLVE THE GREATEST DILEMMA.

1. Adam fell from the holy state, he must suffer the penalty of law for with out penalty the law of El SHADDAI would have no force.
2. God's justice must be served, for without it EL SHADDAI would become unjust.
3. God is a merciful God, but without the show of mercy, EL SHADDAI would be come unmerciful.
4. Acts 2:23 Peter spoke, of the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, in the counsel halls of heaven it must have been decided, an innocent man must die for the sin of others, but there would be none innocent. Rom 3:23
5. I think, I can almost hear the voice of Jesus, EL SHADDAI say, I will go and become a man and die for them.
6. I think, I can hear the father EL SHADAI say, go, for he so loved the world. Jn 3:16
7. Nothing is impossible for EL SHADDAI. Mat 19:26

IV. THE MISSION OF EL SHADDAI

1. He must be born of a virgin, God must be the father, that he would not have the fallen nature of Adam.
 - A. The virgin Mary ask, how shall this be, seeing I know not a man.
The angel answered and said unto her. The Holy Ghost shall come up on thee and the power of the highest shall overshadow thee, therefore also that Holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the son of God. Luke 1:34-35
 - B. When the fullness of the time was come, God sent fourth his Son made of a woman made under the law. Gal 4:4
2. He was born with out a depraved nature, but had to live his life without sin.
 - A. Christ began his ministry when he was about thirty years old, He was first baptized by John the Baptist, then tempted of the devil. Luke 3:21-23, Mat 4:1-11
 - B. For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succour them that are tempted. Heb 2:18
 - C. He was in all points tempted like as we are yet without sin. Heb 4:15 (He is EL SHADDAI)
3. Jesus was EL SHADDAI when he spoke.
 - A. Officers were ask why they did not arrest him, they replied never did a man speak like this man. Jn 7:32-46
 - B. He told the man with palsy thy sins be forgiven thee, the scribes challenged him saying none could forgive sins but God. He said, which is easier to say, thy sins be for given thee or arise take up thy bed and walk. He told the man with palsy to arise take up thy bed and go thy way to thy house. Mk 2:1-11
 - A. He rebuked the wind and said to the sea, peace be still, they said, what manner of man is this Mk 4:39
4. He was EL SHADDAI when it came time to die.
 - A. Knowing what he had to face the next day, He prayed thy will be done. Mat 26:36-42
 - B. When they came to arrest him, Peter tried to defend him, but he rebuked Peter and said, know you not, that I could pray the father and he would presently send more than twelve legions of angels. Mat 26:47-53
 - C. The priest's servants spit in his face, beat him with their fist, and some blindfolded him hitting him with the open hands, saying

prophecy who smote you, but he was able to humble himself and continue his mission. Mat 26:67-68

- D. Pilot scourged Jesus, scourging was great suffering, but he was able to take it and continue his mission. Mat 27:26
- C. The soldiers stripped him and put up on him a scarlet robe and a crown of thorns on his head and mocked him crying hail to the king of the Jews, they spit upon him and smote him on the head, still he remained humble and continued his mission. Mat 27:27-31
- E. They crucified him and the great mob passed by making fun of him saying, if you're the son of God come down from the cross. He could have or the father could have sent the twelve legions of angels but he stayed on the cross finishing the mission to die for us. Mat 27:33-50

V. EL SHADDAI COULD CONQUER DEATH AND THE GRAVE

1. He said, as Jonah was three days and three nights in the whale's belly, so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. Mat 12:40
 - A. EL SHADDAI could keep his promise.
 - B. The twenty four hour bible day began at evening, the evening and the morning were the first day. Gen 1:5
 - C. He was buried Wednesday evening before a Passover Sabbath and arose at evening of the seventh day Sabbath.
 - D. Like the song says, up from the grave he arose, he came out of the tomb with the stone in place, the guards on duty and remained so they thought he was still there but the angel rolled the stone away the next morning and proclaimed to the women that he had risen Mat 28:1-6
2. Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus from the dead. I P 1:3
 - A. Begotten again or the new birth is a spiritual resurrection Eph 2:1
 - B. Like the psalmist we were in the horrible pit and couldn't get out, we tried every thing, we couldn't make it happen, but El SHADDAI could. Ps 40:1-3
 - C. We have a lively hope, He is alive and we are no longer dead in trespass and sins but sealed with the holy spirit of promise which is our earnest or our assurance to the day of redemption. Eph 1:13-14

3. When the last trumpet shall sound there shall be a resurrection of the dead. I Co 15:52
 - A. Sown in corruption, He will raise us in incorruption. I Co 15:42
 - B. Sown in dishonor, He will raise us in glory. I Co 15:43
 - C. Sown in weakness, He will raise us in power. I Co 15:43
 - D. Sown a natural body, He will raise us in a spiritual body. I Co 15:44
4. O death where is thy sting? O grave where is thy victory. I Co 15:55
5. The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death. I Co 15:26

VI. ELSHADDAI SHALL DESTROY THE HEAVENS AND EARTH

1. II P 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works therein shall be burned up.
