

Patience is incorporated with the word "UNTIL" in the Scriptures.

(A) We need patience to wait UNTIL God works His purpose in us.

James 1:2-4: "My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing."

(B) Israel needed patience UNTIL God manifested his miracle and power.

Exodus 14:13: "And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which he will show to you today: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen today, ye shall them again no more for ever."

(C) We shall reap a harvest if we wait UNTIL due season.

Galatians 6:9: "And let us not be weary in well-doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not,"

(D) We are to let the tares and the wheat grow together UNTIL the harvest.

Matthew 13:30: "Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn."

(E) We are to preach the gospel and wait UNTIL the Lord blesses it according to His will.

Isaiah 55:10-11: "For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it to bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth : it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it."

(F) The Lord is a refuge in the storms UNTIL they pass by.

Isaiah 25:4: "For thou hast been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm, a shadow from the heat, when the blast of the terrible ones is as a storm against the wall."
