SAVIOR 1JN 4:14

I. THE GOOD NEWS

- 1. HEADLINE "JESUS THE SAVIOR OF THE WORLD"
- 2. WE ARE REPORTERS AND WE ARE TO REPORT THE GOOD NEWS.
 - A. News reporters often add color. DO NOT!
 - B. 1TIM 4:7 But refuse profane and old wives fables, and exercise thyself rather unto godliness.
 - C. 2 TIM 4:3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine: but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears.
 - D. The need of a Savior comes by hearing the law and it's penalty. ROM 7:9
 - E. JN 3:16 Proves we are saved by faith but the New Testament has thirty more.
 - F. Remember ROM 10:17 Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God.
 - G. 2 TIM 4:2 Preach the word be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.

II. THE SAVIOR OF THE WORLD

- 1. 1JN 4:14 And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent his son to be the Savior of the world.
- 2. 1 TIM 4:10 For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Savior of all men especially of those that believe.
- 3. JN 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish but have everlasting life.
- 4. HEB 2:9 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death for every man.
- 5. LUKE 19:10 For the Son of man come to seek and to save that which was lost.
- 6. MAT 28:18-20 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, all power is given me in heaven and earth, (19) Go ye therefore and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son and of the Holy Ghost. (20) Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you; and low I am with you all ways, even unto the end of the world.
- 7. 2 PETER 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is long suffering to us ward, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.
- 8. ROM 3:21-22 But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; (22) Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe; for there is no difference.

- 9. ROM 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
- 10. JN 12:47 And if any man hear my words, and believe not, I judge him not; for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world

III. THE SAVIOR SAVES FROM SIN

- 1. JN 1:29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sins of the world.
- 2. HEB 9:26b He hath appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.
- 3. JN 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- 4. JER 31:34b I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sins no more.
- 5. 1 JN 1:7b The blood of jesus Christ cleanseth us from all sin.
- 6. REV 1:5 And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood.
- 7. REV 7:14 And I said unto him, Sir thou knowest, And he said to me, these are they that came up out of great tribulation and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.
- 8. Isaiah 1:18 Come now let us reason together, sayeth the Lord; though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.
- Rom 4:3 What sayeth the scripture? Abraham believed God and it was counted unto him for righteousness
 - A. If Abraham was righteous and he was then he had no sin.
 - B. 1 JN 5:17a All unrighteousness is sin.
- 10. 1 JN 3:9 Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remained in him; and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

IV. THE SAVIOR SAVES FROM SPIRITUAL DEATH

- 1. EPH 2:1 And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sin.
- Rom 7:9 For I was alive without the law once; but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died.
- 3. MAT 8:22 But Jesus saith unto him, follow me; and let the dead bury the dead.
- 4. 2 CO 5:14 For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge; that if one died for all then all were dead.
- 5. EPH 5:14 wherefore he saith, awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give you light.
- 6. LK 15:22 It was meet that we should make merry and be glad; for this thy brother was dead, and is alive again; and was lost, and is found.
- 7. JN 3:36 He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life; and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life but the wrath of God abideth on him.
- 8. JN 3:16 For God so loved the world; that He gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish but have everlasting life.
- 9. JN 5:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, he that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

V. THE SAVIOR SAVES FROM PHYSICAL DEATH

- 1. ROM 5:12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned;
- 2. ECCL 9:5a For the living know they shall die;
- 3. ECCL 8:8 There is no man that hath power over the spirit to retain the spirit; neither hath he power in the day of death; and there is no discharge in that war; neither shall wickedness deliver those that are given to it.
- 4. HEB 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment.
- 5. ACTS 17:26 And hath made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation.
- 6. JOB 14:14-15 If a man die shall he live again? All the days of my appointed time will I wait, till my change come. (15) Thou shall call, and I will answer thee: thou wilt have a desire to the work of thine hands.
- 7. JOB 19:25-26 For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the last day upon the earth; (26) And though after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see God.
- 8. ACTS 24:15b There shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and the unjust.

- 9. JOHN 5:28-29 Marvel not at this for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the grave shall hear his voice, (29) And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil unto the resurrection of damnation.
- 11.1 CO 15 Paul makes the following arguments.
 - A. If Christ be not raised there is no resurrection.
 - B. If Christ be not raised our preaching is vain.
 - C. If Christ be not risen our faith is vain.
 - D. If Christ be not raised those fallen asleep in Christ are perished.
 - E. Christ is risen.
 - F. For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.
 - G. The body is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption.
 - H. The body is sown in dishonor; it is raised in glory.
 - I. The body is sown in weakness; it is raised in power.
 - J. The body is sown a natural body it is raised a spiritual body.

VI. THE SAVIOR SAVES FROM THE SECOND DEATH BEFORE IT HAPPENS

- 1. REV 20:14-15 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. (15) And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
- 2. LK 16:23-26 And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. (24) And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame. (25) But Abraham said, son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted and thou art tormented. (26) And besides all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence.
- 3. MK 9:43-47 And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched: (44) Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched. (45 And if thy foot offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter halt into life, than having two feet to be cast into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched. (46) Where their worm dieth not and the fire is not quenched. (47) And if thine eyes offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire:
- 4. PS 86:13 And great is thy mercy toward me: and thou has delivered my soul from the lowest hell.
- 5. PS 116:1-9 I love the Lord because he hath heard my voice and my supplications. (2) Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon him as long as I live. (3) The sorrows of death compassed me, and the pains of hell gat hold upon me: I found trouble and sorrow. (4) Then

called I upon the name of the Lord; O Lord, I beseech thee, deliver my soul. (5) Gracious is the Lord, and righteous; yea, our God is merciful. (6) The Lord preserveth the simple: I was brought low, and he helped me. (7) Return unto thy rest, O my soul; for the Lord hath dealt bountifully with thee. (8) For thou has delivered my soul from death, mine eyes from tears, and my feet from falling. (9) I will walk before the Lord in the land of the living

VII. THE SAVIOR SAVES THE PRESENT LIFE

- 1. EX 20:12 Honor thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land thy God giveth thee.
- 2. EPH 6:1-3 Children obey your parents in the Lord: For this is right. (2) Honor thy father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise; (3) That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.
- 3. The paddle not prayer has been taken out of schools and homes, teaching children to obey will give them a longer life.
 - A. PROV 13:24 He that spareth his rod hateth his son; but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes.
 - B. PROV 23:13-14 Withhold not correction from the child: for if thou beatest him with the rod, he shall not die. (14) Thou shalt beat him with a rod, and deliver his soul from hell.
 - C. PROV 29:15 The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame.
- 4. The married life can be saved by obeying the word of God.
 - A. EPH 5:22-25 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. (23) For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is savior of the body. (24) Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing. (25) Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave him self for it.
- 5. Obeying the word and Spiritual leadership will save your ministry.
 - A. MAT 5:13-16 Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? It is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men. (14) Ye are thee light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hid. (15 Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. (16) Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
 - B. 1 CO 9:27 But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a cast away.
