Subsidized rehearsal space is given at \$10 an hour to accepted choreographers for the creation of new work. Choreographers accepted into the space grant program will be in touch with 92nd Street Y Harkness Dance Center Associate Director, Edward Henkel, regarding the availability and scheduling of rehearsal space. The amount of space allotted to each choreographer is determined by the availability of studio space.
