VISITING HYANNIS

Surrounded by Beauty, Filled with Fun

No visit to Cape Cod would be complete without paying homage at Hyannis, largest village of Barnstable's seven. Hyannis' most recognizable feature is its colorful mile-long Main Street. Filled with more than three dozen restaurants and shops, boutiques and stores galore, the energy along this thoroughfare is palpable. But, turn off Main Street onto other roadways may surprise visitors. The pulsing energy of Hyannis Harbor, a working port, is where ferries shuttle to resort islands Martha's Vineyard (seasonal) and Nantucket. But there are also fishing excursions, harbor cruises, amphibious vehicle excursions and even pirate adventures to be had here. All of their respective throngs of departing or arriving passengers inevitably make their way to Main Street.

Visitors flock to Hyannis because it is the common denominator of Cape life. Millions arrive and depart here on the Cape and island odysseys. It is the peninsula's transportation, commercial, educational, healthcare, mercantile, shopping, cultural and tourism epicenter.

Meandering along Main Street, one hears dozens of languages-many from visitors, but just as many from residents who have made their way here from around the world. The Cape is at once true to its Yankee heritage and surprisingly ethnically diverse, providing an exciting and colorful backdrop for commerce, tourism and daily life. Shopkeepers, gallery owners and restaurateurs hail from dozens of nations, bringing their cultural nuances to bear on the experiences of Hyannis' ever-growing numbers of visitors and residents. One of a kind boutiques stand shoulder to shoulder with Asian, Italian, Thai, Mexican, Peruvian and Indian restaurants, ice creameries and gelateria, souvenir emporia and pizzerias. As visitors gambol along Main Street, they can take a carousel ride, tuck into an international food shop, relax on the Village green, get a massage or facial, lunch on fresh local seafood or stroll the Walkway to the Sea to Hyannis Harbor's artist shanties and seagoing excursions!

Hyannis' six sibling villages—Barnstable, Centerville, Cotuit, Marstons Mills,

HISTORY OF BARNSTABLE

Parson Joseph Hull and his small flock founded Barnstable in 1639. Unwanted in Weymouth, he and his flock settled in land east of the boundaries of Sandwich. Later that year Reverend John Lothrop arrived with a larger flock of Congregationalists. The Lothrop settlement incorporated as the Town of Barnstable (after Barnstaple, Devon, England) whose original boundaries included Saconesset (which changed its name to Falmouth in 1693).

The relationship between early settlers and Native Americans Wampanoags was peaceful. Settlement lands were purchased or bartered. The first purchase (1644) from the native Serunk is today's West Barnstable; the second (1648) from Nepoyetum is Barnstable; the third (1648) from Sachem Paupmumuck included lands from Centerville to Cotuit; and the fourth (1664) from Sachem lyannough is today's Hvannis and Hvannis Port.

Initially Barnstable was largely a farming community until residents incorporated fishing and other trades into its fledgling economy. Shore whaling became a profitable enterprise with try-works on Sandy Neck. Early town pictures are devoid of trees as most of the native forest was felled for the try-works' firewood; clearly trees have re-grown. Today, whales continue to figure prominently in Barnstable but the focus is on whale watching on specialized vessels departing Barnstable Harbor. Barnstable Village was selected

county seat in 1685 with the division of Plymouth Colony and creation of Barnstable County.

Route 6A, originally a Wampanoag trail, was designated as the first County Road. Agricultural settlement concentrated on the north, or Bay, side of town while the south side had evolving shipping and warehousing enterprises on Lewis Bay and shell fishing in Cotuit. Limited industrial development, primarily grist and woolen mills, evolved in Barnstable Village, West Barnstable and Marstons Mills. By 1750, maritime industries centered on Lewis Bay and Barnstable Harbor dominated. Cotuit and Osterville became known for oyster fishing in their bays.

By 1850, the Town grew along Route 6A, West Barnstable's Church Street, Hyannis' Sea and West Main Streets and along Centerville's Phinneys Lane. There were now eleven village centers at each rail stations (the first Cape railroad was built in 1848 and extended to Hyannis in 1853) and seaports. Hyannis airport was built in 1928 one mile north of the central business district. By 1940, development spread outward from Hyannis and along Nantucket Sound in Hyannisport, Centerville and Osterville. Hyannis' growth pattern emanated from the railroad station and Main Street. The Mid Cape Highway (Route 6) will built to Route 132 between 1950 and 1953 and extended to Orleans between 1953 and 1959.

Osterville and West Barnstable—each enjoy distinctive personalities and offer decidedly different experiences. All are coastal towns except land-locked residential Marstons Mills, which boasts Marstons Mills River, once home to a fulling mill and weaving operation. Throughout all Town villages, Wampanoag place names are prevalent. The Wampanoags were indigenous people who settled Cape Cod in the 17th century or earlier. Hyannis is a derivation of Iyannough, the kindly Wampanoag sachem (chief) who befriended early area

settlers and sold present day Hyannis for about £20.

As Hyannis evolves, more visitor and resident services are available. Road improvements, a new airport and air services, new bus service between Hyannis and Providence, RI, a Youth & Community Center, Cape Cod Hospital's new \$20 million emergency center will open spring 2015, there is progress on linking the Town's cycling paths with the Cape's network of cycling paths and many more in the works.



VISITING YARMOUTH

Cape Cod, Within Reach

The three villages of Yarmouth possess several delightfully different personalities, from quaint to entertaining. They comprise 39 miles of coastal shoreline along the prized warm waters of Nantucket Sound and the cool serene Cape Cod Bay, 29 freshwater ponds, two boating and kayaking rivers, 11 saltwater beaches, four freshwater beaches including the 'new Flax Pond' Recreation area with 4,300 acres of open space.

Long before English settlers, many Native American tribes were part of the Wampanoag nation: Pawkunnawkuts occupied the southern section of Bass River; Hokanums lived in the northeast section of town, and Cummaquids in the western section. The entire area of today's Yarmouth was referred to as Mattacheese, "old lands by the borders of water."

West Yarmouth along Route 28 includes

a reflection of the past, where one finds a deserted 17th century grist mill. Suddenly, a cranberry bog separates the landscape and a soaring church steeple in the opposite direction reminding us settlers flocked to Cape Cod primarily for religious freedom and opportunity. Visitors can observe an active Osprey nesting platform in the marsh from the viewing decks at Chase Brook and Mill Creek Parks.

Enter into South Yarmouth past the Parker River as it meanders along an enclave of pricey houses that populate the fingers of land in its path to the Sound. These are prime kayaking waters! Continuing along Route 28, a mix of commercial, residential and recreational undertakings pepper the landscape. A little further eastward, the Veterans Memorial Park at Packet's Landing at Bass River Bridge is a peaceful spot to watch fishing boats underway. At the intersection of Old Main Street, turn



into what's called Bass River. Here the Cultural Center of Cape Cod and a fine collection of period homes provide heady inspiration for cultural activities and a look back at gentler days.

The Village of Yarmouth Port on Route 6A is like a time capsule of early Cape life. Here one finds more than 50 stately sea captain's houses—many now B&Bs—and even more period Cape houses, small farms and a lovely village center replete with ancient stone walls. The Captain Bangs Hallet museum is home to the Historical Society of Old Yarmouth and a wealth of information.

Locate Old Church Street's Ancient Cemetery, where gravestones date back to 1700. A few restaurants, galleries, nostalgic ice cream and antiques shops pepper the undulating roadway. A few turns away, Gray's Beach at Bass Hole, with its 800-foot boardwalk set over salt marsh tidal pools is excellent for observing plant and marine life, osprey nest, and a popular kayaking spot. Nearby Callery-Darling Conservation Area offers 2.4 miles of hiking trails traversing the wetlands, old abandoned cranberry bogs, hardwood forests and scenic residential areas.

Yarmouth's cultural assets, many of which relate to the Town's significant history, include art galleries, Yarmouth Art Guild, Bass River historical district, a dearth of historical buildings throughout town such as the Judah Baker Windmill, Benjamin Gorham Cobbler Shop, majestic and quaint B&Bs, as well as other wondrous structures along Route 6A.

Yarmouth is antique and innovation rolled into one—and both contribute mightily to its appeal. Few towns exhibit the extreme diversity of Yarmouth's three villages. Most importantly, it is truly Cape Cod Within Reach!

KENNEDY LEGACY TRAIL

Inaugurated in 2012, the Trail comprises ten sites significant to the Kennedy legacy. The self-guided walking tour begins optimally at the JFK Hyannis Museum at 397 Main Street in Hyannis and stretches 1.6 miles in one direction, taking approximately 1½ hours to experience.

Starting with the ① JFK Hyannis Museum, and celebrating historic ② Main Street Hyannis, the splendid ③ rose bushes at Main and Pearl Streets (a tribute to Rose Kennedy, matriarch of the Kennedy clan), and continuing to South Street at the ④ St. Francis Xavier Church, summer parish for most of the Kennedy family, and continuing along South Street to the ⑤ Hyannis Armory, where JFK made his acceptance speech after defeating Richard Nixon in the presidential election in November 1959, these tour stops evoke the spirit of JFK.

⑤ Continue along South Street to Aselton Park at the corner of Ocean Street. In 1961, JFK also launched the **⑦** Peace Corps to encourage mutual understanding between Americans and other peoples and cultures by sending American volunteers to work in developing countries. Further along South Street,

3 Cape Cod Maritime Museum, along with its 1886 Crosby catboat replica, Sarah, was made possible by funding obtained by Senator Edward Kennedy. Here the Kennedy legacy continues, sharing their love of the sea and need to preserve and celebrate the Cape's maritime heritage. 9 Nowhere was the Kennedys' sailing tradition more evident than in Hvannis Harbor. One of the most well-known Kennedy pastimes was sailing, often from Hyannis Harbor into Nantucket Sound. JFK and Jacqueline spent many summers sailing with their family in Hyannis Port. Visitors can board vessels to observe the Kennedy Compound from the water from Bismore Park docks at 180 Ocean Street.

Iohn Fitzgerald "Jack" Kennedy (JFK), 35th President of the United States, served from 1961 until his assassination in 1963. At age 43, he was the youngest person and the first Roman Catholic ever elected president. JFK's presidency was very active and addressed many major issues of the day - the Cuban Missile Crisis, Vietnam, Latin America and the spread of Communism, Civil Rights, and he is credited with establishing the Space Program and the Peace Corps.

HYANNIS CULTURAL DISTRICT

Surrounded by Beauty, Filled with Culture

All communities benefit when they look to arts and culture to continually refresh and renew the quality of residents' lives and visitors' experiences. The Town of Barnstable established the HyArts (Hyannis Arts) District in downtown Hyannis, home to local artists with seaside shanties, year 'round artist studios and galleries, free events all year including theater and musical performances alongside Hyannis Harbor, art walks, open studios, art festivals and much more. HyArts District was designated a cultural district by the Massachusetts Cultural Council (MCC) in May, 2012.

Located in seaside Hyannis, HyArts
Cultural District features a wide spectrum of arts and cultural experiences,
outdoor activities, shopping and dining.
Visitors can explore President John F.
Kennedy's Cape Cod roots at the JFK
Hyannis Museum and the new Kennedy
Legacy Trail, immerse themselves in Cape
Cod Baseball League legends and lore
at its Hall of Fame. Along the Harbor
itself, the Cape's rich maritime traditions
are illuminated at Cape Cod Maritime

Museum where one can set sail on the Museum's 1886 Crosby catboat replica, Sarah. View local artists' exhibitions at Hyannis Harbor Arts Center at Guyer Barn or attend free harbor–front concerts at Citizens Bank Tuesday Night Concert series and Sunset Celebrations. Visit the Harbor Shanties to buy work from local artisans or check out any of the dozens of unique shops, boutiques and galleries within the District.

In March 2014, the MCC also designated Barnstable Village as a Cultural District, the Town of Barnstable's second cultural district (and only the second town in the state to have two districts), Cape Cod's fourth and Massachusetts' 20th.

Barnstable's historic walkable Cultural District encompasses Main Street from the Cape Cod Art Association to Rendezvous Lane and from Route 6A (Old Kings Highway/Main Street) to Mill Way Beach and includes a self-guided journey down Main Street featuring historic buildings, cemeteries and gardens.



WALKING TOURS

Mid Cape, On Foot

Barnstable and Yarmouth, spectacular towns for walking tours bounded by Nantucket Sound and Cape Cod Bay are idyllic seaside locales for long exploratory walks with enclaves, parks, historic districts, ponds and lakes, woodland and nature trails throughout both towns' ten villages. Barnstable Village offers a selfguided Historical Walking Tour through 18 significant sites in the Bay-side village, many of these beautifully restored period structures reflecting back to the Town's founding.

The Town of Yarmouth boasts worthy touring on foot, with Yarmouth Port's most popular, the Captains' Mile where walkers will find a stunning collection of historically significant former sea captains' houses along both sides of meandering Old Kings Highway. Not to be missed is Old Main Street and neighborhoods along River Road on Bass River. These charming enclaves present Yarmouth in a far different light. Lovely period homes along this tree-shaded byway harken to a turn of the century bygone era. Flax Pond in South Yarmouth includes yearround Larusso Lodge, shade shelters and wooded pathways leading to the fresh water beach.

Hyannis' HyArts Cultural District comprises 90 acres, including portions of Main and Pearl Streets and energetic Hvannis Harbor itself. This relatively new cultural district celebrates the talent of established and emerging artists against the canvas of Hyannis' colorful cultural scene.

Visitors should also take a stroll through Hyannisport, renowned for its long association with the Kennedy family and site of IFK's former "Summer White House." The charm and nostalgia of the famous Kennedy Compound, scene of those unforgettable touch football games, weddings, summer parties and, of course, tragedy, make it a walk worth taking. Eugenia Fortes Beach behind Hyannisport Yacht Club provides a start and end point. Less strenuous walkers might opt for the Kennedy Legacy Trail, a 1.6-mile self-guiding tour to ten sites significant to the Kennedy family.

YARMOUTH NATURE TRAILS

Scan to view detailed maps of Yarmouth's Conservation land walking trails. Or Download detailed trail maps of Yarmouth's Conservation land walking trails. Should you decide to venture out on any of these trails, be sure to carry a compass and a copy of the map. Poison ivy is an abundant and hearty plant along many of the walking trails so please be careful. Ticks bearing lyme disease are not uncommon on Cape Cod. Dress appropriately and check for ticks at the end of every walk. Take the challenge and walk them all!



PROOF STATES CONSERVATION AREA The trail with the highest point in Yarmouth is situated on what is known as the Sandwich Moraine, a significant glacial feature left over from the last ice age of 20.000 years ago. The area boasts of two scenic vistas. Many side trails and loops occur within this 300 acre land tract. http://ma-varmouth.civicplus.com/DocumentCenter/View/698



CALLERY-DARLING CONSERVATION AREA This trail is located north of Rt 6A and stretches from Homers Dock Rd to the salt marshes west of Center St. The area displays great ecological diversity in various stages of vegetative succession. Soils are rich and deep with organics, indicating an aggressive farming history. Abandoned cranberry bogs and ancient salt water bogs are present with original dikes still intact. The Bass Hole Boardwalk is one of the more popular attractions within the area. http://mavarmouth.civicplus.com/DocumentCenter/View/699



PROOF CRAB CREEK CONSERVATION AREA The trail winds its way along the shore of Crab Creek. This area has long been a favorite of crabbing enthusiasts with its abundance of blue crabs. Callinectes sapidus. Blue crabs measuring five (5) inches from point to point may be taken without a permit.

DENNIS POND CONSERVATION AREA The main trail is approximately 3,285 feet long and winds its way through a variety of woodland communities. HORSE POND CONSERVATION AREA These trails are located within a 400 acre tract of town owned land. The main trail occurs along the northern perimeters of Horse Pond with spurs, loops and connectors to other trail systems. http://ma-yarmouth.civicplus.com/DocumentCenter/View/702



■ ■ MEADOWBROOK CONSERVATION AREA This area consists as brackish marsh, salt marsh and relic Atlantic white cedar swamp fronting on Swan Pond. A 310 foot boardwalk leads from the parking area to the north shore of Swan Pond. http://ma-varmouth.civicplus.com/DocumentCenter/ View/703



RAYMOND J. SYRJALA CONSERVATION AREA This area is 15 acres in size with a trail approximately 3,500 feet in length and forms a loop that passes through a rather wet environment. A man-made reservoir to the east of the trail was created to store water for the now abandoned cranberry bogs. http://ma-yarmouth.civicplus.com/DocumentCenter/View/704



SANDY POND CONSERVATION AREA Sandy Pond is approximately 12 acres in area and presents itself as a classic "kettle" pond with steep slopes and a depth of 35 feet. A nature trail leads around the entire pond and connects to other trails to the north, west and east, http://mavarmouth.civicplus.com/DocumentCenter/View/705



THATCHER SHORE CONSERVATION AREA This area consists of mostly salt marsh with a short trail through a wooded thicket. The marsh end of the trail boasts commanding scenic views of the salt marshes and island thickets. EXPLORE CAPE COD

There are more than a dozen theaters and theater companies on the Cape. Cape Cod Rail Trail treks 22 miles through six towns from Dennis to Wellfleet, Brewster's Museum of Natural History, Brewster Store, Nickerson State Park and historic houses will intrigue.



Harwich features 615 acres of trails and 22 salt and fresh water beaches to explore. Chatham enchants with Chatham Light, Fish Pier, Monomoy Wildlife Refuge and Main Street. Orleans beckons—from Nauset Beach, sprawling Pleasant Bay to Cape Cod Bay sunsets on Rock Harbor.

CYCLING THE MID CAPE

Cape-wide, there are more than 110 dedicated miles of cycling paths. Add to this cycling-friendly trails and roadways and visitors will find it easy to get around the Cape on two wheels. As one crosses our Bridges, it is apparent from the preponderance of bike racks that Cape Cod is a place people love to cycle. Starting in Boston, Claire Saltonstall Bikeway runs from the Charles River and runs 137 miles, passing through Barnstable and Yarmouth en route to Provincetown using existing (not bike-only) roadways.

Barnstable and Yarmouth feature a growing network of cycling trails and cycling-friendly roadways, part of the Cape-wide effort to connect to the Cape Cod Rail Trail which, at present, runs from Dennis to Wellfleet. Barnstable is home to several challenging and unique bike paths, the most notable of which is the renowned and so-called Trail of Tears (West Barnstable Conservation Area), one of the Cape's most popular off-road spots. Others include Hathaway's Pond, Old Jail Lane and Otis Atwood Conservation Areas. Barnstable shares the Hyannis Ponds (Willow Street) with Yarmouth.

Yarmouth's extensive network of cycling paths and roadways will be supplemented by a proposed extension of the Rail Trail from Dennis to Hyannis, part of which is already in place. To cycle this section, park at the lot just west of the intersection of Old Townhouse and West Yarmouth Roads continuing south on Forest Road to Long Pond Road. Yarmouth Port Bicycle Route traverses some back roads and scenic locations along sylvan parts of Great Western Road where riders can tuck into some forested areas. For the pièce de résistance, the route terminates

at magnificent Bass Hole!

Another Yarmouth Port bike trail, Dennis Pond Conservation Area (off Willow Street), offers a ½-mile main trail with a side trail in wooded uplands bordering a scenic pond which is surrounded by white pine, oak, beech and red maple forest. Cyclers continuing to Summer Street will end up at 26-acre Woodside Cemetery which features many beautiful old gravestones, mausoleums, flowering trees and lots of serenity. A particularly interesting fountain sports a metal bird-silhouette archway.

Many visitors prefer to forge their own cycling trails, regardless where they might lead. The Mid Cape offers a splendid locale for cycling with many fascinating and exciting spots to pull off to explore, shop, eat or relax. At every turn, some new undiscovered road or byway will lure intrepid cyclers. After seeing the four corners of Barnstable and Yarmouth strike out beyond their borders. Cape Cod is a cycler's paradise. Not only is the terrain relatively flat with hills interspersed throughout the Cape, but most beaches allow free access to cyclers.

Below is another cycling path to explore.

CAPE COD RAIL TRAIL

(22 miles from Dennis to Wellfleet)

Cape Cod Rail Trail is the granddaddy of Cape cycling paths running through the towns of Dennis, Harwich, Brewster, Orleans, Eastham and Wellfleet. It is primarily flat with well-marked vehicular crossings making it exceedingly safe and enjoyable. Along one side, the Trail features a wide unpaved shoulder for horseback riders, walkers and runners. Bike rentals are readily available at several points with restrooms at Nickerson State Park and Salt Pond Visitors Center.

LAND HO

Surrounded by Beauty, Filled with Recreation

For landlubbers, both Barnstable and Yarmouth have many hiking, walking and cycling trails and conservation land for exploring. Barnstable has at least nine conservation areas as well as its renowned Trail of Tears, a 1.200-acre conservation land in West Barnstable whose recreation focus is multi-use and revolves around mountain biking, hiking, trail running and cross country skiing (hunting is allowed in season). Yarmouth has a half dozen conservation areas and its Historical Society of Old Yarmouth Nature Trail meanders through fifty acres of woodland splendor. Although the trails are now rich with forest vegetation and botanical specimens, this was located on what was Cape Cod's first golf course! Built in the 1890s as a private course for the Thacher family, the course was used for several decades but then allowed to revert to its natural state. Visitors can collect maps showing hiking and walking trails at our visitor centers. Speaking of golf courses, there are more than half a dozen courses in the Mid Cape and as many adventure (mini) golf ven-

ues. But there's more. There are go-carts, arcades, batting and soccer cages, ten-pin and (New England's favorite) candlepin bowling. In Yarmouth, the family will enjoy the Cape's largest inflatable park.

A few blocks from Main Street, the Hyannis Youth & Community Center with two ice skating rinks, two basketball/volleyball courts, skateboard park, walking track, teen game arcade with WiFi and a café. HYCC also is the local venue for competitive sports events attracting regional, national and international competitors.

In Yarmouth, explore the Route 28 corridor from West Yarmouth to the Dennis town line. Here there are many entertainment venues, such as miniature golf courses and ice cream emporia plus some terrific views of Parkers and Bass River, the fascinating old hamlet of Bass River between Old Main Street and the Bass River in South Yarmouth. The Historical Society of Old Yarmouth presents a number of wonderful historic sites to explore,

including famous landmark Hallet's Store on the Old King's Highway, longest contiguous historic district in America. Along the way, visitors will find refreshing freshwater ponds beckoning, wonderful spots for a swim, photograph, painter's easel or hiking the surrounding terrain. Callery-Darling Conservation Area in Yarmouth Port, which runs from the area north of Route 6A and Homers Dock Road on the east side to the salt marshes west of Center Street, is an area of great ecological diversity including pine and oak forests, marshes and bogs, salt marshes, abandoned cranberry bogs (which now support red maple swamps) and an active osprev nest near the 800-foot boardwalk completes a nice circuit. Baxter's Grist Mill, built around 1700 on Mill Pond in West Yarmouth, is an old fulling mill which used to be powered by an exterior water wheel (this was later replaced). It was the first Yarmouth site placed on the National Register of Historic Places and is

open seasonally for tours.

Cape Cod Art Association offers wonderful photography tours in downtown Hyannis Photowalks on which a professional photographer will ensure attendees take home truly wonderful pictures. There is always something cultural happening at the Cultural Center of Cape Cod, from classes and workshops, exhibits, dance lessons and Table Française for adults who enjoy French culture and language and meeting other people who enjoy speaking French, eating French food and sipping French wine.

Barnstable and Yarmouth are treasure chests overflowing with interesting places to see on foot, bicycle or car. Sandwiched between Cape Cod Bay and Nantucket Sound, one is never far from a seaward vista. But shady lanes, four centuries of architecture, beautiful old steepled churches, clam shacks and an enduring history make these twin towns a joy to explore on land.

ON THE WATER

Surrounded by Water, Filled with Excitement

Many think "beaches" when they visit the Mid Cape, even though there is so much more to do than hang out at the shore (despite the fact there are more than 19 sea beaches between both towns and dozens of freshwater ponds). Barnstable has more than 100 miles of beaches and, together with Yarmouth's 15 salt and fresh water beaches, there is a tremendous diversity of water experience throughout these two towns on both Cape Cod Bay and Nantucket Sound. No trip to the Mid Cape would be complete without a visit to Barnstable's Sandy Neck Beach, a six-mile barrier beach, and Great Marsh, a crucial part of the 3,800-acre Sandy Neck salt marsh and barrier beach system. Along with the expansive salt marsh views, the sanctuary features two open ponds, shady oak woodlands and numerous wildlife. In Yarmouth Port, Grays Beach (also known as Bass Hole) has an 800-foot boardwalk extending over salt marsh which provides great views of plant and marine life across Garden Creek and Cape Cod Bay.



Cape Cod Baseball League celebrates its 130th season in 2015 and continues to provide fans with competitive baseball entertainment, where the country's top college players display multi-dimensional skills in their purest forms.

After being populated mostly by GI's returning from World War I in 1919 and World War II in the late 1940s, the CCBL continued to be populated by a combination of local and regional college players until 1963, when it became officially sanctioned by the NCAA. Following a decade (1974-84) of using aluminum bats, the Cape League became the first collegiate summer league to return to wood in 1985 and became even more popular with major league scouts and college players and coaches.

With more than 1,000 alumni performing at all levels of professional baseball a record total 254 former Cape Leaguers populate major league rosters. The list of Cape League all time alumni in major league baseball totals more than 1050 names. The Cape League is recognized

as the best amateur summer leagues in the country by college coaches, as well as professional baseball scouts. Players from around the United States and all college divisions are recruited to play in the tenteam loop. Seeing one's favorite team is never a problem. Teams are located in Bourne, Brewster, Chatham, Cotuit, Falmouth, Harwich, Hyannis, Orleans, Wareham, and Yarmouth-Dennis. Check the schedule online or simply look for "Game Tonight" signs posted in towns that have teams. In the Mid Cape, there are three teams: Y-D Red Sox (playing at Red Wilson Field in South Yarmouth) vdredsox.org; Cotuit Kettleers (playing at Elizabeth Lowell Park, Cotuit) kettleers.org; and Hyannis Harbor Hawks (playing at McKeon Park in Hyannis) harborhawks.org.

BASEBALL CLINICS

Area teams offer weekly instructional baseball clinics for boys and girls ages 5+ throughout the season. Participants learn fundamental baseball skills, good citizenship and sportsmanship from experienced coaches and top collegiate players.





ARTS, CULTURE & ENTERTAINMENT

Surrounded by Beauty, Filled with Arts & Culture

Beauty surrounds us in the Mid Cape—windswept beaches, marshes, fog-shrouded harbors with boats at anchor, lighthouses, shady lanes, stunning architecture—so much of what we see inspires.

Cape Cod Community College hosts performances of Cape Cod Ballet, Opera Cape Cod and Cape Cod Conservatory of Music. Nearby, venerable Cape Cod Melody Tent has presented popular seasonal programs of entertainers "in the round" since 1950. Cape Cod Cotuit Center for the Arts features art exhibitions including works of more than 500 visual artists, more than fifty concerts and 25 full-length theatrical production plus year-round classes and workshops in visual and performing arts.

South Yarmouth's historic Old Main Street, the Cultural Center of Cape Cod hosts more than 900 cultural events annually. The Center lives up to its motto All the Arts for All of Us. The new Education Wing offers recording, photography, painting, and music studios; classrooms for the visual, performing and literary arts plus a culinary arts kitchen. Yarmouth is bursting with arts and culture, galleries, studios, juried art exhibits at multiple venues through Yarmouth Arts Guild.

Hyannis' Annual Father's Day Car Show is Cape Cod's largest non-sporting event which will celebrate its 21st anniversary in 2015, is one of the late spring's most popular events, drawing more than



80,000 attendees. More than 380 classic and nostalgic cars from New England and New York are displayed along historic mile-long Main Street, which is designated pedestrian-only during the Show. Concurrent with this Show is the annual Cape Cod Chowder Fest at the Melody Tent. Not far behind is July 4th and boat parade on Hyannis Harbor, street parades along Hyannis Main Street and other village plus nighttime fireworks high over Hyannis and Yarmouth can be seen for and wide, from the Bass River to Cotuit.

In early August, the 30th Annual Pops by the Sea on Hyannis' Village Green, the Cape's single largest cultural event and summer highlight, will feature Boston Pops Esplanade Orchestra.

From late September to early November, Fall-for-the-Arts is a family-friendly celebration showcasing local arts and culture. The December holiday season welcomes village strolls in Cotuit, Centerville, Osterville and West Barnstable. Hyannis' Village Christmas Stroll features the popular Breakfast with Santa, ice sculptures, a magician, candy cane making, international food and dessert tastings along Main Street, Christmas trolley and duck boat rides, choir and musical performances, Hyannis Harbor boat parade culminating in the popular tree lighting on the Village Green.

Yarmouth Port Christmas Stroll features museums, B&Bs, inns and businesses along Old Kings Highway in holiday array offering treats and seasonal music, photos with Santa at the Bangs Hallet house with caroling and tree-lighting on the Village Common. The Bass River Holiday Cookie Stroll is always a "sweet" event beginning at the South Yarmouth Library.

MID CAPE BEACHES

Surrounded by Beaches, Filled with Excitement!

Between Barnstable and Yarmouth, visitors can luxuriate in nearly two dozen Nantucket Sound (warm) and Cape Cod Bay (cooler) beaches. One of the Cape's greatest beaches is Sandy Neck, a six-mile barrier beach park comprising 3,800 acres of beach, dunes, maritime forest and marshes. Sandy Neck is backed by the Great Marshes. Sandy Neck is more akin to a living museum featuring dynamic landscapes exhibiting ecological activity and brimming with diverse recreation. Tidal inlets and exceedingly low tidal flats and pools provide superb opportunities to observe marine life close up. Nearby, the Mid Cape's only whale watch departs Barnstable Harbor.

Starting with Sandy Neck and continu-

ing through Grav's Beach/Bass Hole in Yarmouth Port visitors will find spectacular, often unnamed, terrain for beachcombing, and educating youngsters about Cape Cod's ever-changing coastline. For exploring rather than sunbathing, seek out some of the North Side's creeks such as Lonetree Creek or kayak to some of the small islands, coves and marshes which thread through the coast of Barnstable and Yarmouth on the Bay. At Gray's Beach on the Bay, between sunbathing and watching the osprey nest, one can trek out the 800-foot boardwalk which rises above the creek, marsh and tidal inlets. This is a prized location for sunsets, too!

Between the Bay and Nantucket



Sound, there are dozens of crystalline freshwater lakes and ponds. Barnstable has 182 freshwater ponds occupying 1,856 acres (93 are a minimum of one acre; more than 25 are greater than ten acres and are "great ponds"). Lake Weguaquet in Centerville covers 654 acres where one can fish for largemouth bass and northern pike. Along with Yarmouth's 28 ponds, there is a great diversity of freshwater experience, including fishing at several. Centerville, Parkers and Bass Rivers are outstanding waterways for kayaking providing yet another dimension to the Cape experience. The entire expanse of the southern Cape coast from Mashpee to West Dennis provides one beach after another punctuated by small islands, breakwaters, bays, coves and harbors, all ideal for exploring via kayak or sailboats.

Nantucket Sound's warm water beaches are a tremendous draw. Compared

to the relatively frigid Atlantic beaches further out on the Cape, small wonder these beach nirvanas are so popular. With warm water, gentle surf and often backed by clam shacks, these sandy crescents of beach are ideal for families with children. From Barnstable's ever popular Craigville Beach (along with more remote Long and Short Beaches along the Centerville River) to Kalmus Beach, mecca for windsurfers, these beautiful strands of sand and water are idvllic. In West and South Yarmouth from Bay View Beach, from which one can watch maritime vessels arrive and depart Hyannis, to Englewood, Colonial Acres, Seagull, Parkers River, Sea View and Bass River Beaches-all offer ideal beaches for families and couples looking for recreation, tranquility and low-key beach-going with a warm sandy welcome. At Bass River Beach, beachgoers can even fish from the pier.
