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WELCOME TO THE PLACE WE PROUDLY CALL HOME!

No visit to Cape Cod would be complete without exploring the Mid Cape's two most popular towns, Barnstable and Yarmouth. So, on behalf of the residents, businesses and respective town Chambers of Commerce, we warmly welcome to you to the place we call home!

These two contiguous centrally located, pleasingly and distinctively unique, towns are convenient points for visitors' Cape-wide pilgrimages. Visitors stream seamlessly between towns by car, bus, bicycle and on foot. The Towns of Barnstable and Yarmouth offer more guest rooms and lodging options than any town pairs. This is no coincidence since there are dozens of beaches, sights and attractions, shopping, dining, recreation and history to explore, all within a relatively short distance.

The family-friendly Town of Barnstable comprises seven villages — each a microcosm of Cape life unto itself. Of these, Hyannis is the most celebrated and renowned. Hyannis is the transportation, commercial, mercantile and spiritual “heart” of Cape Cod.

Barnstable's other six villages — Barnstable Village, Centerville, Cotuit, Marstons Mills, Osterville and West Barnstable — offer a tremendous diversity of experience. From pastoral byways to sandy crescents of stunning beaches, the Town of Barnstable is a high value, year round destination.

The 17-square mile Town of Yarmouth, the Cape's second oldest town, offers three sibling villages — West and South Yarmouth on the Nantucket Sound side and Yarmouth Port on Cape Cod Bay. Each family-friendly village offers a distinctly different experience, from Sound to Bay. Sound-side villages are more commercial and here visitors will find a wealth of shopping, dining and lodging experiences at every price point. Route 28, the main thoroughfare, is the most direct way to work one's way through West and South Yarmouth and, interspersed between larger stores and one-of-a-kind shops, boutiques and galleries. There are quiet streets that lead to small relatively undiscovered expanses of beach and scenic parks of unexpected beauty along Nantucket Sound. There are some lovely



white steepled churches, cranberry bogs, windmills as well as the particularly historic Bass River neighborhood along Old Main Street and River Road, which runs alongside the Bass River.

On the Bay side, the lovely surroundings of Yarmouth Port enchant every visitor. Meandering along Route 6A, the Old Kings Highway Historic District, with its lovely former sea captains' houses, churches, farms and both rustic and grandiose architecture, visitors will find contentment at every turn. At Bass Hole, families and couples can stroll along its 800-foot boardwalk, which extends into the marsh with spectacular views and equally stunning sunsets. On the North Side, visitors will appreciate the many historic sites offered by the Historical Society of Old Yarmouth as well as the whimsy of Edward Gorey House, former home which preserves the life and works of this renowned American author, illustrator, playwright, set and costume designer.

Both Hyannis and Yarmouth Chamber staff know both towns and can assist in directing and accommodating visitors' queries and needs. Whether lodging, dining or a recommended itinerary is needed, a stop in any of three visitor centers will sort you out! For those seeking to make a move to the Mid Cape, insider information and referrals will ease the transition.

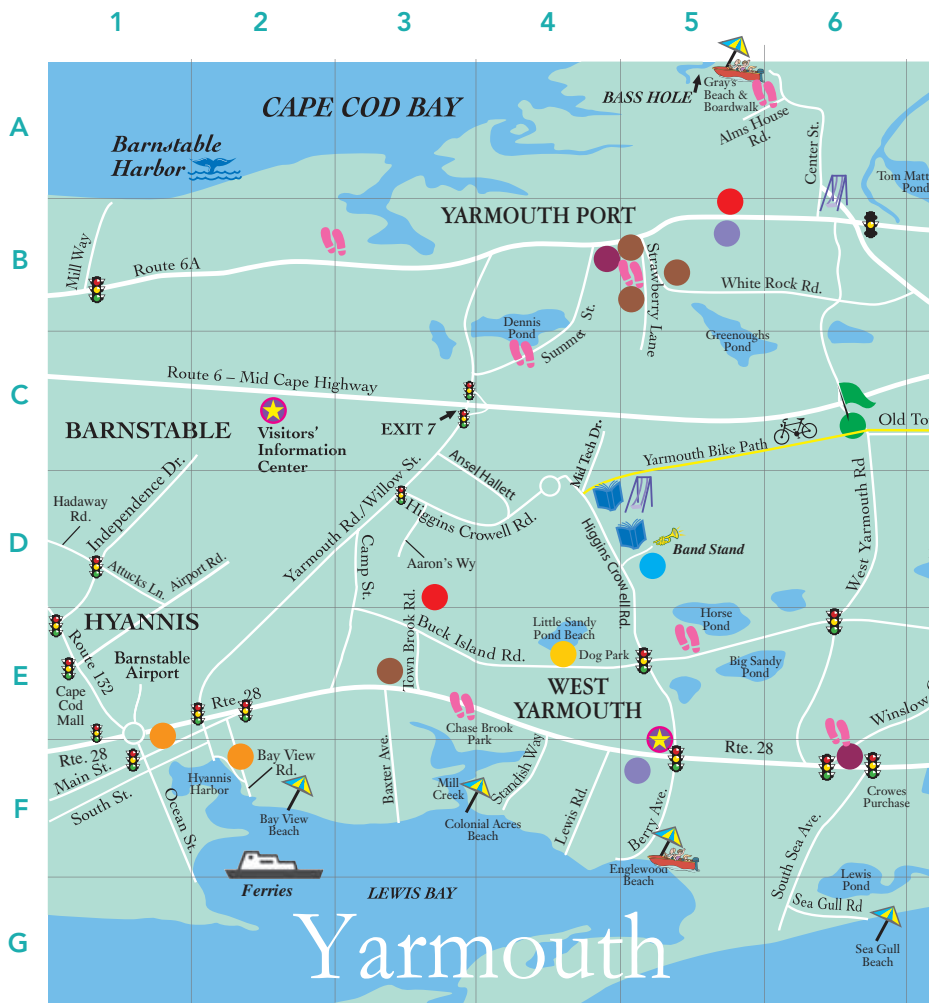

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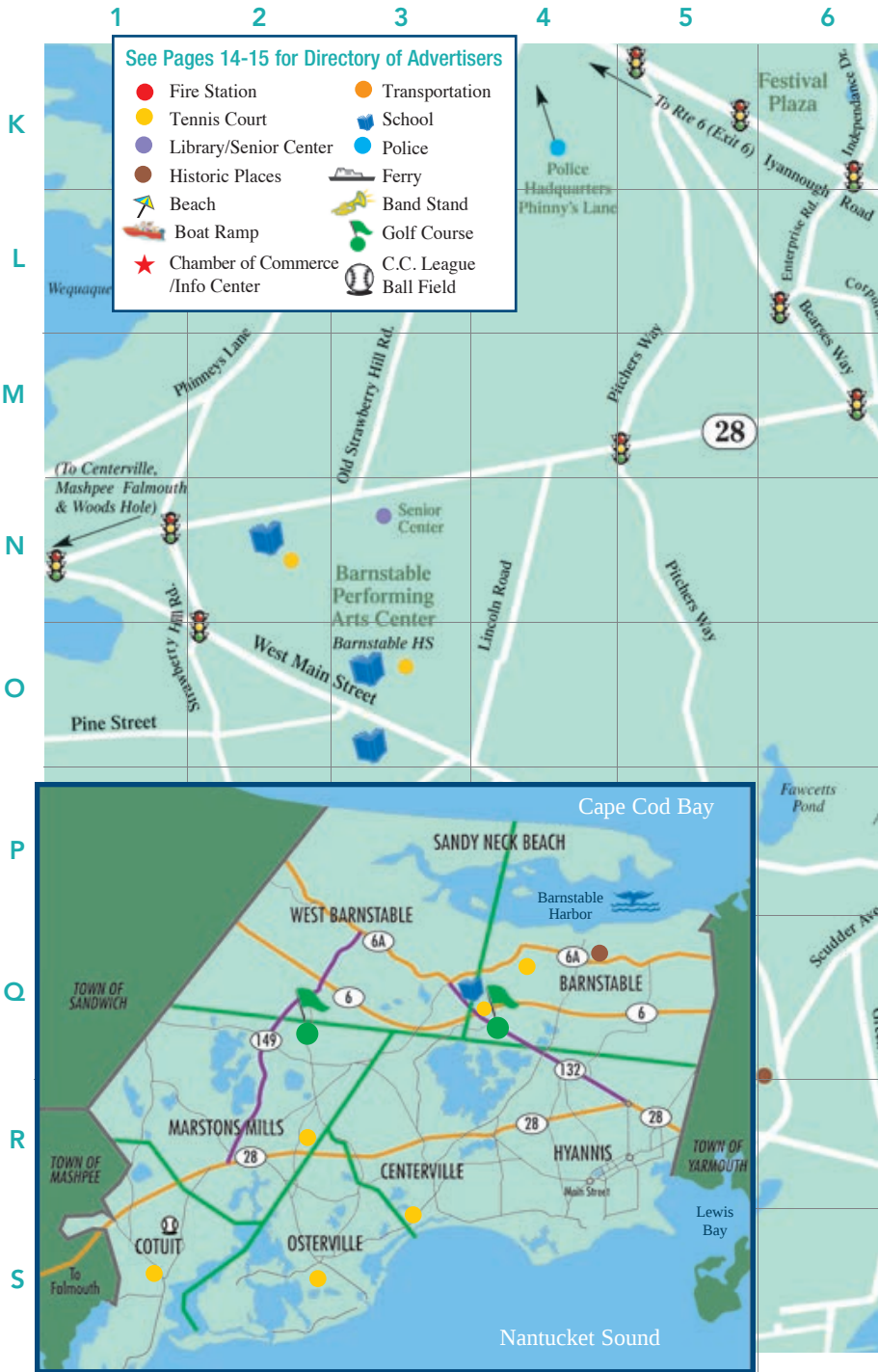

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VISITING BARNSTABLE,

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Visitors wanting the full Barnstable experience should hold on to their hats because there is a tremendous diversity of experience here! The Town of Barnstable comprises seven distinctive and discrete villages, namely Barnstable Village, Centerville, Cotuit, Hyannis, Marstons Mills, Osterville and West Barnstable. The Town is the Cape's largest town in both size and population. Of these, Centerville, Cotuit, Hyannis and Osterville lie along Nantucket Sound. Singular Marstons Mills is an inland village, but it is a special one indeed. Along Cape Cod Bay and Route 6A, the Old Kings Highway, lie Barnstable Village and West Barnstable. Each village offers its own set of charms and "must-sees" so none should be overlooked!

Hyannis — including Hyannisport — is likely the most familiar and renowned village on Cape Cod which has, over the years, taken on a life of its own. It is perhaps most renowned for being the village where the Kennedy family sequestered itself within the so-called Kennedy Compound. Its signature and colorful mile-long Main Street is like hometown America, with more than three dozen restaurants, a wide assortment of shops, boutiques, galleries and stores offering practical and capricious items for vacationers. Main, Ocean and Pearl Streets offer an eclectic array of dining including Asian, Italian, Peruvian, Mexican, continental, gastropub and even vegan. Coffee shop, ice cream parlors, clam shacks, raw bars, brew pub and cocktail lounge, boulangerie and gelateria. Near the airport a local bakery which provides bread to many Cape restaurants offers sells breads, patisserie, sandwiches and sit-down gourmet dining. Within the Cape Cod Mall, many

more dining options are available. These restaurateurs hail from many nations imbuing their cuisines and the village itself with wide cultural appeal.

But Hyannis is also a vibrant community with a diverse collection of residents. It sports varied architecture, lovely old homes and shaded byways to explore. Its harbor, from which ferries shuttle visitors to Nantucket (year-round) and Martha's Vineyard (seasonal), Harbor cruises, fishing charter amphibious vehicle and pirate adventures depart, is a stimulating place for a stroll. It is merely a short and scenic meander from Main Street along the Walkway to the Sea through the Village Green and all around the Harbor. In season, Artist Shanties provide work and viewing space for artists plying their trades for passersby.

Hyannis is the Cape's transportation, commercial, educational, healthcare, mercantile cultural and tourism epicenter. Everyone flocks to Hyannis, common denominator of Cape life, because its appeal is universal. Throughout the year, millions arrive and depart via ferries, buses, trains, airplanes or automobiles. It is not only a substantial beach destination, but a year-round hub for just about anything. The new \$40 million airport has drawn a major national carrier which provides seasonal service to New York City as well as year-round service to and from Boston and the islands in addition to seasonal service to/from New Bedford, Westchester and Providence.

Hyannis' septet of sister villages is a virtual treasure trove. Each deliciously different village is filled with myriad delights and experiences, beauty, charm, interesting sights and recreation.

BARNSTABLE VILLAGE, the County Seat, is historic and user-friendly. Along Route 6A, shoppers thrill to galleries, restaurants, historic library and enchanting period homes; many have been retrofitted to house businesses. Nature preserves dot the village's landscape. Scenic and exciting Barnstable Harbor's popular whale watches depart here as do boats and kayaks. The minuscule and enchanting hamlet Cummaquid along Cape Cod Bay borders Yarmouth Port. Its wooden bridge over Halletts Millpond, lovely homes and coast along the Bay are beautiful.

WEST BARNSTABLE, in the Town's northwest corner, is more rural than the other villages. Its Sandy Neck barrier beach and nature park, largest Mid Cape beach, comprises 4,700 acres of Bay-front beach, dunes, maritime forests and Great Marsh. The fully-restored 1717 Congregational meeting-house, West Parish of Barnstable, is a village icon as is West Barnstable train station (an active station). Nearby, Old Village Store is a historic and prominent local mercantile and social center. There are also cranberry bogs and delightful conservation areas.

MARSTONS MILLS, the Town's only land-locked village, will surprise visitors. The primarily residential village is replete with many lakes, beautiful ponds and cranberry bogs. It is home to a horse ranch, Cape Cod's only grass airport (offering bi-plane rides) and a timeless village center. Burgess Park has Cape Cod's only disc golf course and nearby is 18-hole Olde Barnstable Fairgrounds Golf Course. There is a fascinating 1,200-foot herring run running from Marstons Mills River to Middle Pond in the early spring. For a treat, do not miss Whelan Conservation Area off Old Stage Road.

COTUIT is located on a peninsula bounded on three sides by water and, at five square miles, is one of Barnstable's smallest villages. Its name was derived from Wampanoag "place of the council." It is primarily residential and off the beaten path, offering several small beaches along its 12-mile coast. Its small commercial center reminds us how rural it is. Cotuit includes minuscule sub-village Santuit marking the junction of Main Street, Route 28 and Route 130. Popular village landmarks are Cotuit Center for the Arts and Cahoon Museum of American Art. It would be a mistake to miss Crocker Neck, Santuit Pond Preserve and Long Pond Conservation Area.

CENTERVILLE, formerly Wampanoag Chequaquet (pleasant harbor), is a pastoral community on Nantucket Sound famous for its Craigville Beach in that neighborhood, as well as several smaller beaches and Centerville River, popular with kayakers. It is primarily residential with a business district along Route 28. Centerville is an apt name, as the village is bordered by five of the Town's seven villages except Cotuit. Its Main Street's historic sea captains' homes and the main village center retain earlier charisma. A rural area surrounds Lake Wequaquet, site of Chequaquet's earliest settlements, and comprising 656 acres and nine miles of shoreline. Wequaquet is the second largest "great pond" (a pond or lake at least ten acres in size) on Cape Cod.

OSTERVILLE was purchased from native Wampanoags when they called it Cotacheset for two copper kettles and some fencing—a cheap price for what has evolved into such a prestigious address. It was renowned for harvesting wild oysters, re-named Oysterville. When a map misspelled the name as Osterville, the name stuck. White clapboard Main Street is nostalgic and a wonderful place to shop and dine. This delightful residential community is home to many waterfront mansions and traditional homes. Its desirable beach, Dowses, is a wide, breathtaking expanse of sand almost completely surrounded by water. Summer population swells when second homeowners descend upon this tony village. Lovely Armstrong-Kelley Park, Cape Cod's oldest, largest privately-owned park, is favored for picnics and weddings. Osterville Historical Society Museum houses the original Crosby boat building shop.



VISITING YARMOUTH:

West & South Yarmouth and Yarmouth Port

The Town of Yarmouth spans the girth of Cape Cod with West and South Yarmouth bordered by Nantucket Sound's warm water beaches and Yarmouth Port on cooler Cape Cod Bay. This trio of villages — offering 39 miles of glorious coastline, 11 saltwater and four freshwater beaches, more than two dozen crystalline ponds and two boating and kayaking rivers, embodies a wide range of recreational and cultural experiences — beaches, golf, fishing, visiting historical sights and architecture, arts and culture, boating and kayaking, shopping and dining.

The transition between Hyannis and West Yarmouth is seamless and a 17th century grist mill on the north side of Route 28 welcomes visitors to its commercial corridor, home to many hotels, motels and restaurants interspersed with antiques shops, thrift stores and jewelers, galleries and craft studios, an expansive cranberry bog and some lovely waterfront parks. Along this route the visitor will find just about anything to buy, eat or purchase as well as a cluster of services and necessities. Wending one's way westward, Nantucket

Sound makes an appearance from time to time and when Route 28 veers left, take the right fork and explore timeless Bass River and its Old Main Street and other byways which cluster up against Bass River itself. This charming neighborhood, with its eclectic period architecture and off-the-beaten path feel, visitors can get a sense of "olde Cape Cod." The Cultural Center of Cape Cod, with its majestic façade, is the cultural epicenter of the Cape itself. This older neighborhood extends across 21st century Route 28 to North Main Street with Bass River Mercantile and the Yarmouth Art Guild's showcase, the Artists' Paintbox gallery. Along Cape Cod Bay on Route 6A in Yarmouth Port, there are many art galleries as well. The Historical Society of Old Yarmouth preserves the town's past at nearly a dozen historic sites clustered around town but primarily along 6A. Such standouts as the recently renovated and re-purposed circa 1870 Gothic New Church, Winslow Crocker and Captain Bangs Hallett Houses and others. At Tufts Gatehouse, visitors can explore 50 acres of woodland nature trails rich with forest vegetation and botanical specimens.



Yarmouth is a destination for families with a wide range of family-friendly lodging at every price point. Families are drawn to Yarmouth with such a compelling collection of family-friendly sights, attractions and recreation. A new inflatable park and challenge park offer a whole day's activities. There are miniature golf courses as well as a whole sports world with go-karts, sports cages, game arcade and driving range. Yarmouth is home to a half-dozen playgrounds, recreation areas and parks including two newer scenic parks along Route 28 in West Yarmouth and Packet Landing along the mighty Bass River, itself another major natural and recreational asset.

The 23-acre Taylor-Bray Farm, established in 1639, is home to livestock such as goats, Scottish Highland cattle, donkeys, chicken and sheep. This free (donations welcome) attraction organizes many farm, fall, holiday and sheep festivals and activities plus has a boardwalk extending into Black Flats Marsh. An on-site archeological site suggests Native Americans occupied parts of the Farm at least 3,500 years ago!

Not far from the Farm, the fascinating Edward Gorey House is a museum located in the former home of this prolific American author, illustrator, playwright, set and costume designer, humor-

ist and animal welfare devotee. Gorey (1925-2000) wrote the dark and timeless Gashlycrumb Tinies, his most iconic alphabet book and likely his best known work. Changing annual exhibits illuminate Gorey's life and works. Every summer the House hosts its Fantasagorey Day children's festival. For families traveling with their dogs, be sure to let them unwind leash-free at Yarmouth's new dog park at Sandy Pond Recreation Area on Buck Island Road. Newly refitted Flax Pond alone offers more than a hundred acres of conservation land with many amenities such as a ball field, volleyball, basketball court, picnic area along the shores of this sparkling Pond. Golfers will find plenty of green here in town, with four public golf courses and some challenges along with some great vistas!

In the quieter seasons, there is no shortage activities! March brings the St. Patrick's Day Parade; April, yes, April enjoy the North East Santas Convention; early summer it's Yarmouth Summer Kickoff Celebration; in autumn enjoy the Yarmouth Seaside Festival and Taste of Yarmouth; in December enjoy the Yarmouth Port Christmas Stroll and Bass River's Cookie Stroll.

One season rolls into the next, all surrounded by the immense beauty of Yarmouth.

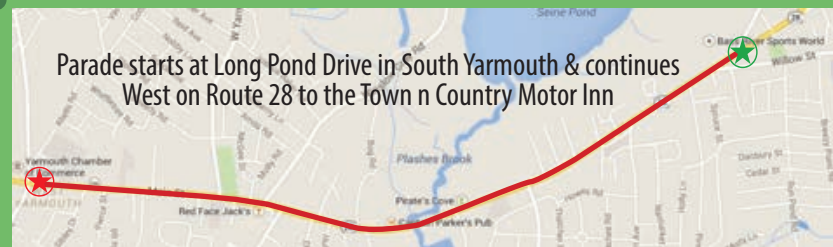

CULTURAL DISTRICTS

Barnstable Village Cultural District

In March 2014, Barnstable Village was designated a Cultural District by Massachusetts Cultural Council. The Barnstable Village Cultural District evolved several years ago from a self-guided walking tour featuring 18 historic sites. The walkable Village is filled with historic buildings, intriguing shops, active working artist studios and galleries, locally-owned shops, musical and theater groups, and restaurants. Visitors and locals can immerse themselves in four centuries of history or fast forward to the 21st century's many advances. From natural history to the arts, history, architecture and haunted village tours, Barnstable Village is a diverse and pleasing destination featuring both active and more relaxing pastimes, sights and attractions. The Village is an architectural treasure chest brimming with magnificent and pristine examples of many building styles, each complementing

the illustrious history of the Village.

In addition, there are live performances at Barnstable Comedy Club and outdoor concerts, lectures and gallery tours, historic and natural history and ecological tours as well. Local artisans and potters are happy to share knowledge of their respective crafts as are artists at Village galleries. In addition to the foregoing, there are imaginative shops and restaurants to round out the cultural experience here. Let's not forget festivals throughout the year.

At Barnstable Harbor, take a fully narrated and breathtaking whale watch to Stellwagen Bank to observe these magnificent mammals in their natural habitat. Nearby Barnstable Great Marsh is an integral part of the ecologically significant 3,800-acre Sandy Neck salt marsh and barrier beach system.



Whether one lives nearby or is visiting, the Village of Barnstable offers endless cultural and recreational options just a short ride from Hyannis!

HYARTS CULTURAL DISTRICT

The exciting HyArts District in and around Main Street and along the Harbor in Hyannis provides a collection Town-owned properties at Pearl and South Streets including Guyer Barn, Gallery Artrio, Bass River Pottery @ 50 Pearl and Sarah Holl Artspace where talented local artists' works are displayed. Designated a cultural district in May 2012, within these spaces and locales, one will discover new and emerging local artists and view public art pieces throughout Main Street and its waterfront, connected by the meandering Walkway to the Sea. A performing arts program provides entertainment at Aselton Park, atop the scenic and compelling waterfront at Hyannis Harbor. A bricked walkway winds around the Harbor from the Steamship Authority, along the entire Harbor and up to Main Street.

Hyannis is practically synonymous with the storied Kennedy family, whose Cape Cod roots can be explored at JFK Hyannis Museum and Kennedy Legacy Trail, ten Kennedy-significant locations which circle through the Village. Cape Cod Maritime Museum celebrates, preserves and interprets the Cape's maritime past, present and future. Through inspiring passion and respect for the sea, the Museum presents his legacy and explored how the sea continues to shape Cape Cod. Visit the Harbor Shanties to buy work from local artisans or check out any of the dozens of unique shops within the District.

Hyannis Main Street, Cape Cod's "downtown," is home to numerous specialty shops, eclectic restaurants offering international cuisines, venues with live music and more. Library, art galleries, fascinating international purveyors, artisans, jewelers and collectibles offer an ever-changing array of art, crafts and merchandise to entice and satisfy that urge to acquire!



CONSERVATION AREAS AND HIKING TRAILS

in the Town of Barnstable

The Town of Barnstable is a real place, but throughout its seven villages, intrepid explorers can step ‘off the grid’ into the marvelous outback. Here one can find serenity, natural wonders, wildlife, beauty, lakes and ponds, indigenous flora and fauna within more than 1,854 acres of conservation land excluding Sandy Neck Beach Park, which alone comprises 4,700

acres. Between the Town of Barnstable’s 6,554, MA Audubon’s 398 and Barnstable Land Trust’s 1,056 acres, there are more than 8,008 acres of conservation land in Town plus the 365-acre Hyannis Ponds property.

These conservation properties are very diverse, many include vernal or other ponds, several include rivers and creeks



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and, of course, Great Marsh, Long Pasture, Sampsons Island and the mammoth Sandy Neck include access to the ocean. Trails can be hiked or cycled year round and the experience in each season is unique. During the warm weather, trails can be narrower because of foliage but no less enjoyable. The remarkable diversity of flora and fauna is ample reward. In the colder months, when trees are bare, even wider and more remarkable vistas can be enjoyed.

Hyannis Ponds comprises 365 acres in an assembly of coastal plain ponds just north of Barnstable Airport. This site is significant because one finds here unexpected

rare species concentration of 15 nationally-restricted, state-listed rare species found together at these ponds. It is one of the richest rare plant communities in the region. Some of these rare species are found here in greater numbers than found anywhere else in Massachusetts or the world, and some have their most viable populations here. These include Plymouth gentian, long-beaked bald-sedge, Barrens bluet damselfly and decodon borer moth. Other pondshore species generally rare in the region, but locally abundant in these ponds, include thread-leaved sundew, pondshore knotweed and inundated beak-rush, among others.



ARTS & CULTURE

In Yarmouth

With an illustrious history and artistic inspiration just about everywhere, Yarmouth is filled with arts and culture. Bass River's Cultural Center of Cape Cod alone hosts more than 800 events annually. The Center offers painting, dance, cooking, wine appreciation and other classes so visitors can make their vacation more productive. There are dozens of art galleries and craft studios, theater and cultural venues such as Yarmouth Port's spectacular Gothic New Church. Here visitors can attend concerts, appraisals and other events inside this magnificent restored space.

Also in the village, the Historical Society of Old Yarmouth manages nearly a dozen fantastic town-wide properties which hearken back to Yarmouth's glory days. One glorious structure, the 1840 Captain Bangs Hallett House, provides an intimate perspective into 19th century family life. Visitors could easily spend

a week exploring and delving into the fascinating history of Yarmouth through visiting these sites and website. Along a mile-long stretch of Route 6A, Old Kings Highway, called Captains' Mile every building was built prior to the 19th century.

In Bass River there is a collection of fine old homes as well. This section of South Yarmouth paralleling the Bass River is the oldest settlement on Yarmouth's south side. It is home to the Cultural Center of Cape Cod and the Yarmouth's main library. Many of the antique homes lining the shores of Bass River were moved from Nantucket. It's narrow streets showcase the original street lights that makes this historical location a wonderful place to wonder about.

There is a cluster of arts and cultural events which span the entire calendar. The Yarmouth Art Guild, which grew from 25 to more than 225 artists offers



instruction in a variety of media and presents several shows annually. Its Artist's Paint Box gallery on historic North Main Street in South Yarmouth was acquired in 2014 is a showcase for its members, possibly seeding the area for a pocket of art galleries and other cultural institutions.

Every summer, Yarmouth offers a free summer concert series on Monday evenings in July and August at Parker's River Beach. Visitors and locals bring beach chairs and blankets plus dancing shoes throughout the season. The music is diverse, from Brazilian to Swing, and there is just no better way to spend a lovely summer evening! Every week a different musical ensemble presents its own selection of music.

The culinary arts also thrive in Yarmouth and each year November's Trolley Tour Taste of Yarmouth, a four-hour sort-of traveling food festival featuring more than a dozen restaurants followed by a two-hour after-party. Participants are trolleyed to restaurants on the tour which offer appetizer-sized dishes; some offer entertainment as well.

At Packet Landing, on the Yarmouth side of the Bass River Bridge, visitors and locals can enjoy benches and grassy areas all within sight of the mighty Bass River and the Marina. This is a beautiful spot to set up an easel or tripod for taking some wonderful photos of the River and seagoing vessels. There are several art galleries nearby and the historic Bass River enclave which contains the Cultural Center of Cape Cod, South Yarmouth Library, several charming bed & breakfasts and the historic 1791 Judah Baker windmill, moved to River Street, Bass River in 1866 from East Dennis. June's Run/Walk for the Arts is a professionally-timed 5K run through scenic Bass River, a non-competitive 5K walk and a kids' fun run for children under 10 years old. In August, Yarmouth's free Celebration of the Arts Festival at the Cultural Center is one of the Cape's best, featuring premier artists, artisans and crafters selling jewelry, paintings, pottery, textiles, wood carvings, hand-made note cards, painted tiles, glass art, photographs and more.



CONSERVATION AREAS

in Yarmouth

Town-wide there are nine conservation areas with rustic trails managed by Yarmouth Conservation Commission and the Division of Natural Resources. Some of these are along Cape Cod Bay with marsh, Sandy Neck or seaward vistas while most others surround kettle ponds. In addition, the Yarmouth Conservation Trust has also preserved an additional 219 acres across the Town, some of which have trails to explore.

Historic Society of Old Yarmouth also manages about 50 acres in Yarmouth Port and visitors can meander the gentle trail through more than 50 acres of woodland splendor towards Miller's Pond. These trails are rich with forest vegetation and lovely botanical specimens which have evolved over the past century as this acreage was once Cape Cod's very first golf course. Built in the 1890s as a private course for the Thatcher family, the course was used for several decades but

then allowed to revert to its natural state. Even today the course landscape is evident, especially to golfers. In early June, there is a particularly lovely grove of rhododendrons.

Of these sites, there are several standouts. Callery-Darling Trails in Yarmouth Port start at Gray's Beach near the 800-foot Bass Hole Boardwalk. Here visitors can explore and view Cape Cod Bay and the surrounding marsh as well as exploring the extensive trail system. Those who time it right will be treated to spectacular sunsets year round from this location. At Bud Carter Conservation Area, one of Yarmouth's larger ones at about 300 acres, there are some compelling views of Manomet in Plymouth from the summit of a large sand pit and another of Rocky Farm Bog on Weir Road from the Loop Trail. This second view is particularly beautiful during the cranberry harvest in the fall.

Horse Pond Conservation Area is the Yarmouth's largest conservation parcel at about 400 acres of Town-owned land. Here explorers can view the effects of glaciation on the terrain, most particularly a "dry kettle" — a depression left by a large piece of glacial ice that remained after glacial recession — created as glaciers retreated and outwash streams deposited soils and clays around the depression. The result is a truly remarkable topographic depression. The 30-acre Horse Pond shoreline is subject to considerable fluctuation due to area wells. These fluctuations provide an optimal location for many endangered plants and, in summer, Plymouth Gentian thrive here.

Meadowbrook Conservation Area in West Yarmouth has a 310-foot handicapped-accessible boardwalk from the parking area, through a salt marsh past an ancient Atlantic white cedar swamp which fronts Swan Pond's north shore. There is an expanse of salt water cattails and salt marsh grass. The viewing area offers a

superb vista of the pond and surrounding area. Seasonally, river herring and alewives enter the Pond from Parker's River and climb fish ladders to Long Pond to spawn. This migration is followed by Ospreys who nest nearby. Abundant migratory waterfowl and birds make this area a joy for birders in particular who will enjoy the familiar squeal of spring's red-wing blackbirds roosting among the cattails.

A little effort will yield a bounty of additional information about additional conservation/hiking areas in town. Naturally, bring a trail map (if available), compass, keep cell phones charged and wear good hiking shoes. Beware of poison ivy, the most abundant plant; wear tick repellent and check yourself for these possible disease-carrying pests.

CYCLING THE MID CAPE

Cape Cod offers more than 110 miles of cycling paths and trails. In addition, throughout its 15 towns, many residential and suburban areas, conservation trails and roadways lend themselves readily to cyclists. Take note of the many cars with bike racks, one indication that the Cape is a cyclist's paradise. Starting in Boston, Claire Saltonstall Bikeway runs from the Charles River and runs 137 miles, passing through Barnstable and Yarmouth en route to Provincetown using existing (not bike-only) roadways.

Barnstable and Yarmouth feature a growing network of cycling trails and cycling-friendly roadways, part of the Cape-wide effort to connect to Cape Cod Rail Trail which, at present, runs 22 miles from Dennis to South Wellfleet. The Trail's extension from Route 134 in Dennis to South Yarmouth has been a 20-year effort by the Town of Yarmouth. The project is now underway and planners anticipate the 3.7-mile extension to Station Avenue in South Yarmouth will be complete for the 2017 summer season. The section from Dennis to Yarmouth will include a 160-foot-long bridge over Bass River and will include a scenic overlook of the River. The next two sections, from Station Avenue to Mary Dunn Road and Mary Dunn Road to Route 132, or some alternative routes, should be completed

by 2019.

Barnstable is home to several challenging and unique bike paths, the most notable is the renowned so-called Trail of Tears (West Barnstable Conservation Area), one of the Cape's most popular off-road spots. Others include Hathaway's Pond, Old Jail Lane and Otis Atwood Conservation Areas. Barnstable shares the Hyannis Ponds (Willow Street) with Yarmouth. These conservation areas are more for mountain biking than regular racing bikes. The terrain tends to be irregular, rocky with considerable amount of exposed roots. Throughout Barnstable's seven villages, there are many serene locations for cycling, especially on the Bay-side, along Route 6A, the Old Kings Highway and many quiet residential areas. Even busy Hyannis has some particularly quiet and enjoyable areas such as Scudder, Ocean, Irving and Dale Avenues and Squaw Island Road in Hyannisport, Ocean Street neighborhoods just behind the Hy Line docks and along the Harbor, among others.

Yarmouth's extensive network of cycling paths and roadways will be supplemented by the Rail Trail extension. This section can be cycled presently by parking at the lot west of the intersection of Old Townhouse and West Yarmouth Roads



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and continuing south on Forest Road to Long Pond Road. Yarmouth Port Bicycle Route traverses some back roads and scenic locations along sylvan parts of Great Western Road where riders can tuck into some forested areas. For the *pièce de résistance*, the route terminates at magnificent Bass Hole! Another Yarmouth Port bike trail, Dennis Pond Conservation Area (off Willow Street), offers a ½-mile main trail with a side trail in wooded uplands bordering a scenic pond which is surrounded by white pine, oak, beech and red maple forest. Cyclers continuing to Summer Street will end up at 26-acre Woodside Cemetery which features many beautiful old gravestones, mausoleums, flowering trees and lots of serenity. A particularly interesting fountain sports a metal bird-silhouette archway.

Many visitors prefer to forge their own cycling trails, regardless where they might lead. The Mid Cape offers a splendid locale for cycling with many fascinating and exciting spots to pull off to swim, explore, shop, eat or relax. At every turn, some new undiscovered road or byway will lure intrepid cyclists. After seeing Barnstable and Yarmouth, strike out beyond their borders. Cape Cod is a cyclist's paradise. Not only is the terrain relatively flat with hills interspersed throughout the Cape, but most beaches allow free access to cyclists.

Below are some other cycling paths to explore.

SHINING SEA BIKEWAY (*10.7 miles North Falmouth to Woods Hole*) This beautiful path skirts the shore at several points including West Falmouth Harbor, Oyster Pond, Great and Little Sippewissett Marshes, Salt and Oyster Ponds along Surf Drive with lovely views of Vineyard Sound and Martha's Vineyard as its winds through four of Falmouth's eight villages.

CAPE COD CANAL CYCLING PATHS, BOURNE (*seven miles on each side of the Canal*) Cape Cod Canal Bike Paths traverse both sides of the Canal providing a scenic and exhilarating ride. Cape Cod is a cyclist's paradise. Not only is the terrain relatively flat with hills interspersed throughout the Cape, but most beaches allow free access to cyclists.

CAPE COD RAIL TRAIL (*22 miles from Dennis to Wellfleet*) Cape Cod Rail Trail is the granddaddy of Cape cycling paths running through the towns of Dennis, Harwich, Brewster, Orleans, Eastham and Wellfleet. It is primarily flat with well-marked vehicular crossings making it exceedingly safe and enjoyable. Along one side, the Trail features a wide unpaved shoulder for horseback riders, walkers and runners. Bike rentals are readily available at several points with restrooms at Nickerson State Park and Salt Pond Visitors Center.

CHATHAM BIKE TRAIL (*7.5 miles from Harwich to Chatham Center*) Chatham Bike Trail is a spur of the Cape Cod Rail Trail and extends eight miles through Harwich to Chatham Center from the Rail Trail's bike rotary. Starting out well shaded, the Trail clears as one progressed with many small hills (could be challenging for young riders). Cyclers pass nostalgic Chatham Airport and cross Old Queen Anne Road; the Trail ends after Peoples Cemetery.

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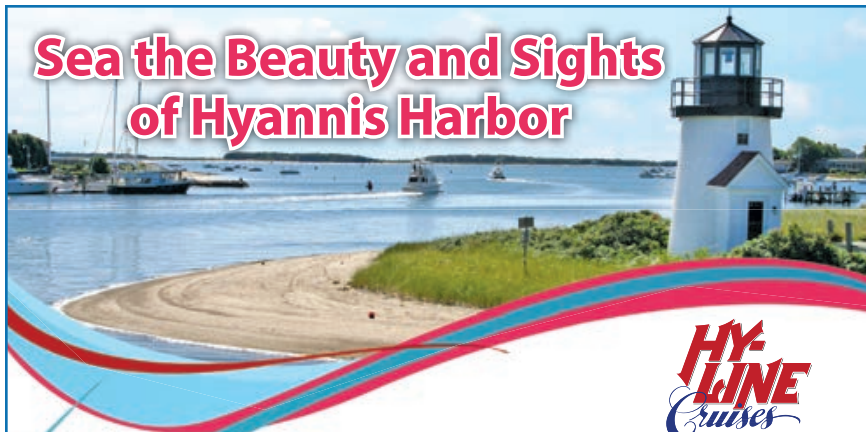
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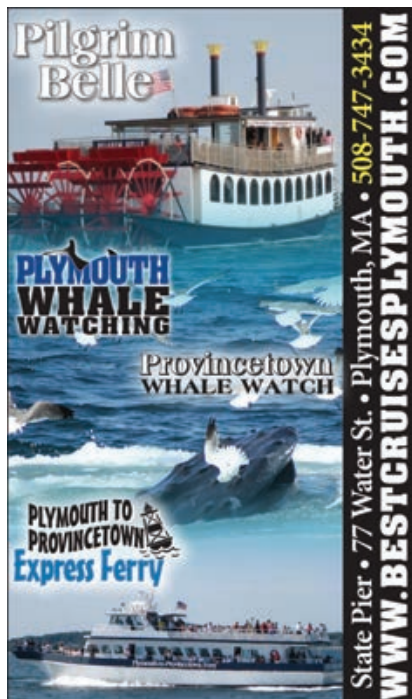
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FOUR SEASONS

in the Mid Cape

Cape Cod has long been associated with summer and, small wonder. Its magnificent beaches, pleasant summer temperatures and endless array of recreation, dining, shopping and geographic diversity make it a paradise for travelers of every stripe. Whether traveling solo, as a couple, family, extended family, business or tour group, Cape Cod will excite and woo you. Long summer days in the Mid Cape are dreamy. The air is filled with the heady perfume of beach roses (*rosa rugosa*), suntan lotion and the tang of the sea. Waiting lines at popular beaches, ice cream parlors, clam shacks are just part of the fun.

But something happens to the air in the autumn. There are soft sounds of insects luxuriating in the gilded September and October sunlight. Cranberry bogs start to redden and are soon flooded with crystalline water with ruby red cranberries floating atop the water to be corralled and shipped around the world. Roses and other flowers are still blooming. Shell fishermen are bringing in tremendous clam, oyster and scallop harvests. Beaches are quieter, sometimes devoid of other bathers and beachcombers. Kayakers love this time of year as the golden sunlight burnishes sea grass tawny gold. Whale watch boats are still packed on weekends, but not so much during the week. Golfers are out on the fairways enjoying warm morning or afternoon sun. After dark, it's so enjoyable to slip on a light sweater and head to a local pub or restaurant for fresh fish or clam chowder.

The autumn is perhaps the best time to take pictures on the Cape. The air is drier and clearer, sunlight is softer

and more gilded. It is also a popular time to paint. Many plein air artists can be seen painting in the magnificent autumn sunlight. The autumn, after the leaves have begun changing over from green to the Cape's spectacular palette of colors — purple, ruby, sienna, ochre, tawny, burnt orange — is an optimal time to explore the Mid Cape's nearly 10,000 acres of conservation lands and trails with inland forests, shoreline loops, trails along terminal moraines or around crystalline ponds. There are many autumn harvest festivals around the Cape including the annual Yarmouth Seaside Festival on Columbus Day weekend. During its nearly 40-year history, the Festival has included a craft fair, food vendors, live musical entertainment, family fun rides and games, high-quality children's events, kayak and canoe race, 5K road race, pie-eating contests, fireworks display and a beach bonfire.

October visitors will enjoy Restaurant Week in the Mid Cape and beyond where a variety of popular restaurants offer three- and four-course exhibition menus from \$25 to \$35. South Yarmouth Fall Market features hand-made crafts, alpaca yarns and products, fine jewelry, baked goods and pastries, jams and jellies, soaps and sundries, farm fresh eggs, produce, local honey and more runs Saturdays in October and November. CapeAbilities Farm offers many Also in October is the Fall Festival at 22-acre Taylor Bray Farm in Yarmouth Port is another spot for pumpkins plus hay wagon rides, games, live music, face painting, archaeology display, hearth cooking demonstration

and, of course, visiting with its farm animals. CapeAbilities Farm on Route 6A in Dennis features a fall bounty of award-winning tomatoes, cucumbers and lettuce plus organic fruits and vegetables from area farms. CapeAbilities also has a working farm in Marstons Mills featuring a historic home and barn; produce grown there is brought to the Dennis farm stand to be sold.

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SEA

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ON THE WATER

One inescapable fact about the Mid Cape, one is practically surrounded by water, north and south. In addition to the fabulous 19 beaches in the Towns of Barnstable and Yarmouth, there are also other stretches of shoreline and marsh between beaches and many crystalline lakes and freshwater ponds. Glacial ponds are often turquoise and are cool and refreshing, even on the sultriest summer day. These are the ideal spots to swim, float, photograph, paint or hike the surrounding shoreline. There are marshes and salt marshes, former cranberry bogs now supporting red maple swamps. A number of ponds once sup-

ported grist or fulling mills (such a mill scrubbed oil and dirt from raw wool, pounding loose fibers into a solid mat). Two such places are the 1700 Baxter's Grist Mill (seasonal tours) which stands on Mill Pond in West Yarmouth and Marstons Mills' Mill Pond where a fulling mill stood until the late 1800s but washed away during periodic river floods.

Most visitors to the Mid Cape come here for its glorious beaches and other bodies of water. Whether one is swimming, sunbathing, beachcombing, fishing, boating, kayaking or windsurfing, spending time at the shore is what the Cape is all about so get out there!

The premier amateur baseball league in the nation since 1885, the Cape League embarks this June on one of its most exciting slates to date, featuring a 44-game regular-season schedule and an action-packed postseason made up of best-of-three quarterfinal, semifinal and championship series.

The Cape Cod Baseball League celebrates its 131th season in 2016 and continues to provide fans with competitive baseball entertainment in which the country's top college players display multidimensional skills in their purest form.

After being populated mostly by GIs returning from World War I in 1919 and WWII in the late 1940s, the CCBL continued to be populated by a combination of local and regional college players until 1963, when it became officially sanctioned by the NCAA.

Following a decade (1974-84) of using aluminum bats, the Cape League became the first collegiate summer league to use wooden bats in 1985 and became even more popular with major league scouts and college players and coaches.

With more than 1,100 all time alumni performing at all levels of professional baseball in 2015, a record total 292 former Cape Leaguers populate major league rosters, including New York Yankees center fielder, Jacoby Ellsbury

(Falmouth 2004), former Cy Young Award winner, Tim Lincecum (Harwich '05), slugging first baseman, Mark Teixeira (Orleans '99), AL Manager of the Year, Eric Wedge (Yarmouth-Dennis '88), AL Comeback Player of the Year, Carlos Pena (Harwich '96/Wareham '97) former Cy Young Award, winner Barry Zito (Wareham '97 & '98), former AL MVP, Frank Thomas (Orleans '88), former AL batting champion, Nomar Garciaparra (Orleans '93), former NL Fireman of the Year, Billy Wagner (Brewster '92) and New York Yankees manager, Joe Girardi (Cotuit '84).

Seeing your favorite team is never a problem. Teams are located in Bourne, Brewster, Chatham, Cotuit, Falmouth, Harwich, Hyannis, Orleans, Wareham and Yarmouth-Dennis. The Cape League relies on these communities for their support.

From housing and jobs for the players, to volunteer work within the league itself, the league could not enjoy its growing success without a total team effort. The hard work by each franchise pays off, as the ultimate reward is to see the stars of tomorrow take the field on Cape Cod today.

Barnstable & Yarmouth

Golfers thinking their Cape visit means being stuck at the beach, forget about it!

With four golf courses in Barnstable added to Yarmouth's two, and more than seven times that number Cape-wide, the region is a golfer's mecca. Barnstable's Hyannis Golf Club and Olde Barnstable Fairgrounds Golf Course are both 18-hole championship courses and have both been acclaimed in *Golf Boston*, *Travel & Leisure* and *New England Journal of Golf*. Yarmouth's three 18-hole courses—the classic Donald Ross-designed Bass River Golf Course and Bayberry Hills Golf Course, Sports Illustrated pick of the Top 5 Par-54 Courses in America—make this a town worthy of your clubs.

This year significant improvements are planned for both Yarmouth's Bass River and Bayberry Hills courses. Bayberry Hills will get new golf cart paths from tee to green on all 18 holes. The course's bunkers, areas surrounding its greens and tees will be renovated.

At Bass River there will be upgrades and renovations including tee, bunkers and green surrounds and a bridge will be replaced. Bayberry's ninth hole was renovated in fall 2015 with plans for golf cart paths beginning in July 2016.

Blue Rock Golf Course, open to the public all year, is a course for all ages and abilities. Designed by golf course architect Geoffrey Cornish, it is meticulously maintained. Holes range from 103 to 255 yards, with the ninth as Blue Rock's signature hole: at 169 yards over water to a kidney-shaped green, this hole was named one of Cape Cod's 18 Best. On the Bay-side, Yarmouth Port's Golf Club at Yarmouth Port is a par-59 18-hole course, nestled into the Bay-side historic district, features magnificent Cape Cod Bay and coastal estuary views to inspire a great game! A walk worth mentioning starts behind the Historical Society of Yarmouth. The 50-acres walk is dotted with trails which were home to the first private golf course on Cape Cod.

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MID CAPE SIGHTSEEING AND RECREATION

Blessed with a tremendous variety of activities and sightseeing, the Mid Cape can easily occupy every member of the family or individual with its endless cultural, recreational and sightseeing diversity. Everyone knows that Barnstable and Yarmouth are fortunate enough to have the magnificent Nantucket Sound and Cape Cod Bay beaches. Beyond the beach, such as on rainy days or when one's historical curiosity, inner athlete or cultural side seeks expression, it's all here in the Mid Cape. There are thousands of acres of conservation land and many miles of beautiful hiking and walking trails to explore on foot or bicycle. Golfers will appreciate the half dozen golf courses in Barnstable and Yarmouth, some award-winning, but all challenging and a pleasure to play on. For not-so-serious golfers, tuck in to one of the several mini-golf courses. One offers even more than just mini-golf. We are talking about Go-karts, batting and soccer cages, golf driving range, game arcades. Family amusement centers are fun for the whole family for parents concerned about too much sun, or if the kids just want to play. The new inflatable park in West Yarmouth is a paradise for the whole family with inflatable rides, challenge park, toddler zone and café.

For some insights into Cape history, culture, maritime heritage, people of color there are four larger museums and more than a half dozen historical societies, some of which feature historical museums. Many children are naturally curious about history and culture, and they will readily engage with the family-friendly exhibits and staff. These interactions and visits will enhance their visits as well as stimulate their curiosity about the Mid Cape. Beyond the Mid Cape, there are many more museums and historical societies. Each town has a number of libraries where periodicals, local information and Wi-Fi as well as peaceful surroundings abound.

Cape Cod Baseball League is the leading amateur summer league in America. Barnstable has two teams: Hyannis Harbor Hawks and Cotuit Kettleers; Yarmouth's team is the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox. All evening games are free for spectators and provide an exciting family outing. Cape Cod Senior Softball League, started in 1987 as Cape Old Timers Softball League, is simply dedicated to senior softball and comprises men and women aged 55 and older. Since organizing, the League has expanded to more than 250 active players, each bringing a variety of skills and abilities to 20 teams.



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These energetic seniors take to the field with youthful exuberance, ready to play with vim and vigor. There are three divisions: Division 1 is for seniors ages 55-65; Division 2 is for seniors ages 66-74; and Division 3 is for seniors 75 and up. Each team is sponsored by a local business and teams play from Memorial Day to Labor Day weekend on weekend mornings and late afternoons and evenings weekdays at eight ball fields in Chatham, Dennis, Harwich and Yarmouth. The League sponsors the Cape Cod Senior Softball Classic, an annual six-day tournament just after Labor Day, drawing teams from across America in five different age classifications. Annually, this tournament brings more than 1,300 players and families from off Cape Cod, in addition to a number of teams playing on the Cape during the regular season.

In Hyannis, Hyannis Youth & Community Center is a state-of-the-art accessible facility for recreational programs, special events and competitive sports competitions. There are also ice skating at two rinks, gymnasium, yoga classes, basketball/volleyball courts, skateboard park, game arcade and more. There are a number of playgrounds for youngsters at most town parks such as Veterans Park, Barnstable Community School which include combinations of play accessories. Luke's Love Boundless Playground in West Barnstable is a fun playground and is handicapped-accessible as well. Yarmouth's playgrounds, which include various play amenities such as swings,

basketball, softball and baseball and tennis courts, include Station Avenue, Fred Thatcher Church Street, Peter Homer and the fantastic Flax, Long and Sandy Pond Recreation Areas, Parker's River Beach, Wilbur Park plus a number of others throughout town. Both Towns' parks are ideal places for jogging, although a seaside jog is heavenly, too. There are also nearly a dozen tennis courts throughout the two towns.

For railroad buffs, take an excursion aboard Cape Cod Central Railroad which offers scenic coastal excursions including woodlands, sand dunes, cranberry bogs, salt marshes and the famous Cape Cod Canal. There are also lunch and dinner trains plus special events throughout the year. Many visitors enjoy a drive or cycle along Route 6A, the Old Kings Highway, a former Native American path along the Cape's north side. The Highway meanders through seven towns. It is one of the Cape's most beautiful byways for scenic vistas, architecture, charm, trees and flowers, quaint shops and galleries and, naturally, Cape Cod Bay nearby.

Barnstable and Yarmouth are treasure chests overflowing with fascinating places, activities, sights and recreation. Sandwiched between the Sound and Bay, a water vista is ever nearby. Intriguing shady lanes, untrammled byways, spectacular gardens and rustic shops always beckon curious visitors. Make the turn, step inside and explore the wonder of these idyllic towns.



MID CAPE BEACHES

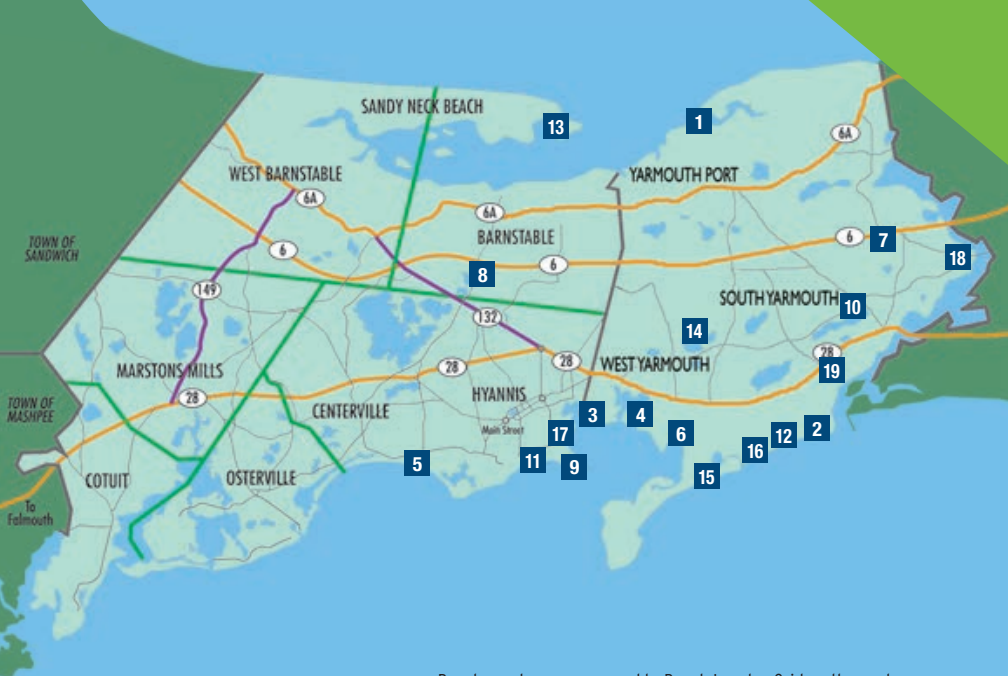
Surrounded by Beaches, Filled with Excitement!

Between Barnstable and Yarmouth, visitors can luxuriate in nearly two dozen Nantucket Sound (warm) and Cape Cod Bay (cooler) beaches. One of the Cape's greatest beaches is Sandy Neck, a six-mile barrier beach park comprising 3,800 acres of beach, dunes, maritime forest and marshes. Sandy Neck is backed by the Great Marshes. Sandy Neck is more akin to a living museum featuring dynamic landscapes exhibiting ecological activity and brimming with diverse recreation. Tidal inlets and exceedingly low tidal flats and pools provide superb opportunities to observe marine life close up. Nearby, the Mid Cape's only whale watch departs Barnstable Harbor.

Starting with Sandy Neck and continu-

ing through Gray's Beach/Bass Hole in Yarmouth Port visitors will find spectacular, often unnamed, terrain for beachcombing, and educating youngsters about Cape Cod's ever-changing coastline. For exploring rather than sunbathing, seek out some of the North Side's creeks such as Lonetree Creek or kayak to some of the small islands, coves and marshes which thread through the coast of Barnstable and Yarmouth on the Bay. At Gray's Beach on the Bay, between sunbathing and watching the osprey nest, one can trek out the 800-foot boardwalk which rises above the creek, marsh and tidal inlets. This is a prized location for sunsets, too!

Between the Bay and Nantucket

Sound, there are dozens of crystalline freshwater lakes and ponds. Barnstable has 182 freshwater ponds occupying 1,856 acres (93 are a minimum of one acre; more than 25 are greater than ten acres and are “great ponds”). Lake Wequaquet in Centerville covers 654 acres where one can fish for large-mouth bass and northern pike. Along with Yarmouth’s 28 ponds, there is a great diversity of freshwater experience, including fishing at several. Centerville, Parkers and Bass Rivers are outstanding waterways for kayaking providing yet another dimension to the Cape experience. The entire expanse of the southern Cape coast from Mashpee to West Dennis provides one beach after another punctuated by small islands, breakwaters, bays, coves and harbors, all ideal for exploring via kayak or sailboats.

Nantucket Sound’s warm water beaches are a tremendous draw. Compared

to the relatively frigid Atlantic beaches further out on the Cape, small wonder these beach nirvanas are so popular. With warm water, gentle surf and often backed by clam shacks, these sandy crescents of beach are ideal for families with children. From Barnstable’s ever popular Craigville Beach (along with more remote Long and Short Beaches along the Centerville River) to Kalmus Beach, mecca for windsurfers, these beautiful strands of sand and water are idyllic. In West and South Yarmouth from Bay View Beach, from which one can watch maritime vessels arrive and depart Hyannis, to Englewood, Colonial Acres, Seagull, Parkers River, Sea View and Bass River Beaches—all offer ideal beaches for families and couples looking for recreation, tranquility and low-key beach-going with a warm sandy welcome. At Bass River Beach, beachgoers can even fish from the pier.

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BED & BREAKFASTS AND COUNTRY INNS

Bed & breakfasts, or B&Bs, and country inns are found throughout the Mid Cape, reflecting the plentiful supply of historical and period houses. B&Bs offer lodging,

breakfast and sometimes afternoon tea but no lunch or dinner. Inns are larger than B&Bs and sometimes also offer lunch and/or dinner. Most of these properties offer in-room, or en suite bathrooms while some smaller properties have rooms that also share a bath with other guests.

COTTAGES, CONDOMINIUMS & HOUSE RENTALS

Some travelers prefer the independence and privacy offered by rented lodging. In addition to having more space, there is often a yard for children, pets, recreation and BBQs. Many such properties offer swimming pools or are located near beaches, making them even more appealing. For larger families, vacation rentals can be a more economical choice, as well.



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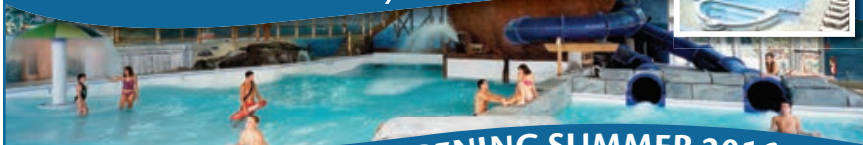
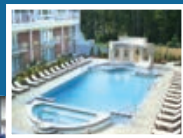
