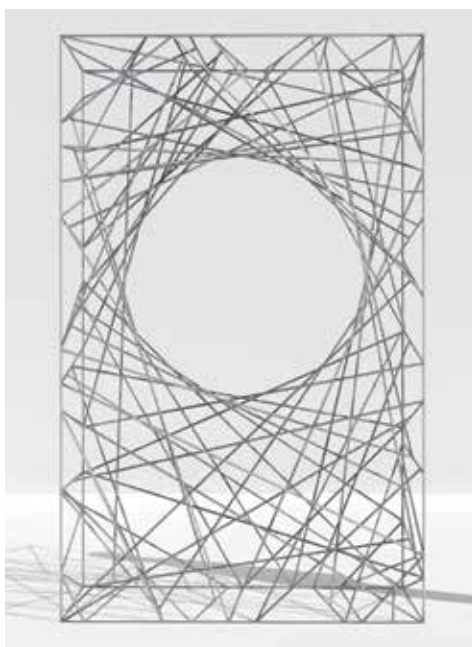

KCAI is pleased to, once again, partner with the A. Zahner Company and Metalabs for a biennial sculpture design competition. Zahner has worked with our students and alumni to create 10 unique sculptures for the Art & Design Auction for the past seven events. The company donates their time and materials to build the sculpture, which is then sold to provide 100% of the proceeds for student scholarships.

This year's contest was open to all KCAI students and alumni. The collaboration celebrates the generosity and ingenuity of A. Zahner and the creative vision of the artist. Caleb Bowman ('99 Sculpture) was selected as this year's artist. Caleb's design, *The Consistency of Change*, was chosen from a field of 22 entrees and four finalists. "Working with Zahner was a chance to push my sculpture in ways I could never do by myself in the studio," said Bowman.

Bowman knows what it's like to not be able to afford college. He says if it wasn't for the scholarships he received, he wouldn't have been able to attend KCAI. "Giving back to the auction is my way of directly having an effect on students. I know that somewhere there is an 18-year-old farm kid making paintings in his basement, just like I was. A scholarship will give him or her the same opportunity it gave me."

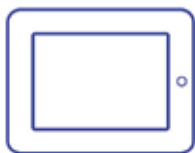

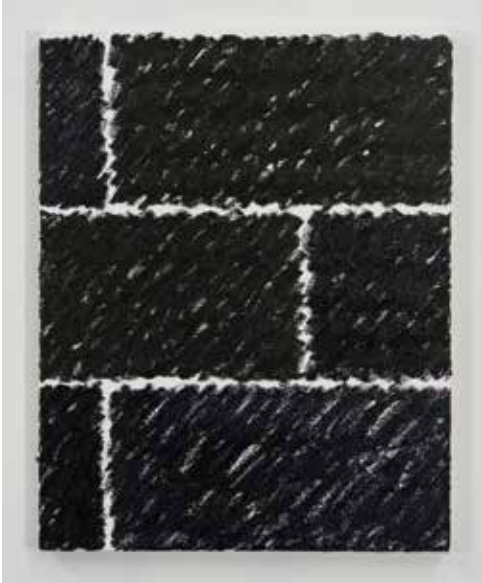

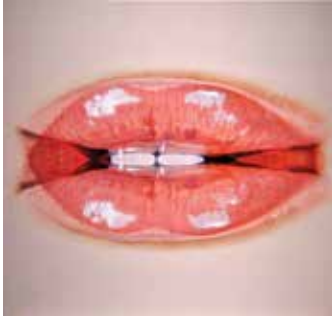

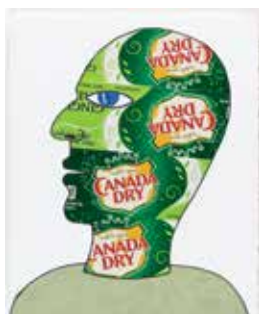
