School choice remains hot subject in Oklahoma

School choice continues to spark heated debates in Oklahoma with critics saying programs like education savings accounts and vouchers only benefit the affluent and pull funding away from public schools to benefit charter and private schools.

Supporters of school choice, however, say parents should have choices for their child's education, which in turn would strengthen all schools by increasing expectations and competition.

Oklahoma has programs in place that allow parents some measure of school choice, including charter schools, virtual charter schools, home schools and scholarship opportunities to attend private schools.

Oklahoma currently has two school-choice programs for private schools. The Oklahoma Equal Opportunity Education Scholarship offers individuals and businesses state income tax credits for donations to nonprofit organizations that give scholarships to private school students. Lindsey Nicole Henry Scholarships for Students with Disabilities provide students with special needs school vouchers to attend a private school of their parents' choice.

In addition, parents can apply to transfer their student to a school district other than the one assigned by the location of their residence or apply to have their child attend any of the schools within the school district.

Supporters of school-choice programs, including Oklahoma-based ChoiceMatters, say parents need even more control over the decision of where their child should go to school.

"School choice actually allows parents to make decisions of where their child goes to school and the tax dollars follow that child," said Robert Ruiz, executive director of ChoiceMatters. "The school choice options we have right now include charter schools, which allow parents in a district or

geographical area to apply for their child to attend. We have 11 charter schools in the Oklahoma City metro, and of those, most have a waiting list.”

Ruiz said school choice would especially help low-income families.

“For urban, low-income families, we have 3,000 on a waiting list and another 7,000 contacted our organization about school choice,” he said.

“Right now, most upper- and high-income families have school choice – they can afford private schools. But a lot of families do not have that choice.”

Ruiz said the fight against expanding school choice in Oklahoma is always based on finances. Public schools get federal funding per student, so allowing parents to have a choice would threaten some schools.

“It’s almost always a financial issue. When you talk about not letting kids go to a different school, it’s about the money, not what’s best for the kids,” Ruiz said. “Ideally, what would happen, is all schools would become more successful if parents had a choice. They would have to be.”

Others claim that school choice would only harm public education and put a financial strain on an already struggling public school system.

One option is the idea of school vouchers, or education savings accounts, that allow parents to choose a private school for their children and use all or

part of the public funding to do so. Under such a program, funds typically spent by a school district would be allocated to the family in the form of a voucher to pay partial or full tuition for their child’s private school, including both religious and non-religious options.

Several bills to create education savings accounts were filed this session at the Oklahoma Legislature. However, only one bill advanced, and it was later pulled by its author.

Authored by state Sen. Rob Standridge of Norman, Senate Bill 560 would have allowed parents to use state tax dollars that would normally go to a public school toward private school tuition, tutoring, textbooks, online education, college admission tests and fees for concurrent enrollment.

Standridge pulled his bill in March, saying he didn’t think he had the votes.

Opponents said such a bill would pull even more money from public education and would send much needed dollars to private schools.

“Vouchers, or education scholarship accounts, will further compound this situation, negatively affecting the funding of every district in the state of Oklahoma,” Oklahoma City Public Schools Superintendent Aurora Lora said in a statement.

The School Boards Association said, based on its own financial analysis, SB 560 would have taken up to \$30 million

away from public schools in the first year and \$1.6 billion over a decade.

For Mid-Del Schools Superintendent Rick Cobb, vouchers are his biggest concern.

“I only oppose vouchers. Taking tax dollars to fund private schools without any oversight is a huge concern,” he said. “Using public dollars to fund sectarian instruction is another one. All students in Oklahoma’s public schools would suffer as vouchers would further deplete funding.”

Further voucher programs would only take away funding from public schools, he added, saying parents already have school choice.

“We already have public school choice. Our district has over 1,000 students attending on transfers right now,” Cobb said.

Dallas Koehn, a ninth-grade history teacher in Tulsa, says the term “school choice” is disingenuous.

“School choice rhetoric loves to suggest deep concern with poor kids trapped in failing schools. That’s simply not true. Taken as a whole, American schools compare quite nicely to schools from around the world when you adjust for poverty and related circumstances,” he said.

“Vouchers don’t add any choices that parents don’t already have. What vouchers do is change where the money goes – that’s all. We already intentionally undercut public education. Vouchers would take more out of the system.”
