PROGRAM REGISTRATION

Registration is now open and available online at www.ankenyiowa.gov/register or walk-in. Payment is due at the time of registration. Some classes have limited availability or a minimum number of participants may be required.

PAYMENT

All fees must be paid in full at the time of registration. Fees due may be paid in cash, credit card or check. There is a \$20 fee for any returned check. If a check is returned, both the amount of the check and the returned check charge must be covered by cash or credit card.

CONFIRMATION

Please note that Ankeny Parks & Recreation will not generate confirmations or reminders for any program. Participants are asked to mark their calendars accordingly. If you have questions about a program registration, call 515-963-3570.

NONRESIDENT FEE POLICY

A resident is defined as a person residing within the city limits of Ankeny or within the Ankeny Community School District. For most programs, an additional fee is assessed for nonresidents.

REFUND POLICY

- 1. Any refund request must be made at least seven days in advance of the program start date.
- 2. Refunds will be given in the form of a credit to an individual's Parks & Recreation account. The refund credit will retain 100% of its value for one year from the date of the refund request and can be used towards any program, special event or aquatic center season passes.
- Ankeny Parks & Recreation will NOT issue cash, check or credit card refunds.

CANCELLATIONS

Programs that are canceled or postponed due to weather conditions, equipment failure or other unforeseen circumstances will be announced as soon as possible. After business hours, information will be available by calling the weather hotline at 515-963-3575. Parents are asked to pick up their children from the program site as quickly as possible if adverse weather conditions occur. PARK SHELTERS*

Park shelters are available for private rental at the following parks:

- Dean Hawkeye Heritage Hillside Northcreek Otter Creek
- Sawgrass Summerfest Sunset Sunrise

If the park is not listed, the shelter can be used at no charge on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Non-Ankeny residents will be charged an additional fee to reserve a shelter. Reservations can only be made a maximum of six months in advance and cannot be made within 72 hours of the reservation date. Shelters can only be reserved from April 7 – Oct. 7.

ANKENY SKATE PARK 1400 NW Prairie Ridae Drive

The Ankeny Skate Park features more than 9,000 square feet of concrete with elements that attract skateboarders of all ages and skill levels. The park consists of a 15-foot diameter bowl with 6-foot walls, 6-foot and 3-foot quarter pipes, grinding rails, 4-foot pyramid, fun box, ramp, stairs, roll-in areas. shelter and benches.

LAKESIDE CENTER

Hawkeye Park, 400 NW Lakeshore Drive

This 3500-square-foot building has tables and chairs for up to 250 people with a full kitchen. The facility is perfect for receptions, parties or business meetings. Reservations are taken up to one year in advance.

OUTDOOR EDUCATION CENTER 610 NF 36th St.

The Outdoor Education Center is available for rent and has a capacity of 50 people. The building has tables and chairs and a small kitchen. Reservations are taken up to one year in advance

ANKENY BANDSHELL

Wagner Park, 410 W First St.

The Ankeny Bandshell can be rented on a first-come, first-serve reservation basis. The Bandshell is an excellent place for small or large events. Rentals are for a full-day only.

PRAIRIE RIDGE SPORTS COMPLEX* 1510 NW Ash Drive

The Prairie Ridge Sports Complex, a 124-acre facility, consists of sports fields for football. baseball, softball and soccer. For rental information, call the PRSC complex office at 515-963-3577.

DISC GOLF COURSE* Heritage Park, 300 NE Frisk Drive

The disc golf course features an 18-hole course with Mach 3 baskets and tees with cement pads with signs. The course consists of gradual hills, many trees, and minimal water hazards with a mix of tight and open holes.

ANKENY DOG PARK 1155 SW Ankeny Rd.

The Ankeny Dog Park is a 7.5-acre park that allows dogs of all sizes to run freely in an entirely fenced in area. The Dog Park features a half acre pond, separate small and large dog areas, and open green space for dogs to run. A Dog Park Pass is required to visit this park. Day passes and annual passes are available at City Hall, Parks & Recreation Office and at both Ankeny Hy-Vee locations, All residents must have their dog licensed with the City (\$10 per animal) and have a current rabies vaccination certification in order to obtain the Dog Park

CITY PARKS & FACILITIES

Pass. Dog Park passes are \$25 and are valid for one calendar year. Daily pass is \$5. Nonresidents may purchase a pass for \$35.

REGIONAL TRAIL MAPS AVAILABLE

OUTDOOR WINTER FUN

Residents are encouraged to use City parks during the winter months. Please adhere to ice safety guidelines and protect yourself from cold weather.

PUBLIC ICE SKATING

Ice skating is available at the retention pond located west of Cascade Falls Aquatic Center at the corner of SW Cascade Falls Drive & SW 18th St. Ice thickness will be rated on a regular basis and skaters should look for the green flag for safe skating conditions. If the ice is determined to be unsafe to skate, a red flag will be flying.

ICF FISHING

Ice fishing is allowed on all public ponds and all fishing regulations must be obeyed. A fishing license is required for everyone age 16 and older. A list of fishing holes can be found at www.ankenyiowa.gov/fishing.




