



OVERVIEW

An intimate 34-room hotel, ARRIVE Wilmington is located in the heart of charming downtown Wilmington, N.C., near Wilmington Riverwalk, a full mile of scenic boardwalk that hugs the borders of the riverfront, providing endless views and easy access to Cape Fear Coast beaches.

Each thoughtfully appointed guestroom provides a cozy home-base for your coastal vacation, featuring Bellino Fine Linens and plush robes, Salt & Stone bath amenities, a mini fridge with a curated minibar of gourmet snacks, Apple TVs with live TV streaming apps, Victrola Bluetooth speakers, and high-speed Wi-Fi. The Loft also offers a kitchenette and sunken TV den. Onsite restaurant Dram Yard serves Southern coastal cuisine with global influences, while the courtyard garden Gazebo Bar prepares refreshing cocktails and flavorful snacks to enjoy around a firepit or at the bowling green.

LOCATION

Defined by its rich past and a bright future, Wilmington, N.C., is a vibrant riverfront city with timeless character that has preserved its historic places, while fostering an ever-evolving independent spirit. The city mingles historic architecture with modern design and new attractions like an event pier near the Port City Marina, hotels, restaurants and a waterfront park – all connected by the nearly two miles of scenic Riverwalk. The city is home to a thriving arts and cultural scene, scenic cruises, a World War II battleship and the 230+ block National Register Historic District, brimming with Victorian-era homes and gardens. Having served as the background for several Hollywood film and television productions, Wilmington is also known as “Hollywood East” or “Wilmywood.”

The hotel is a 10 minute-drive from the airport, and WAVE transit, which operates fixed bus route services, offers easy public transport to and from the airport.

ARRIVE Wilmington transformed what was once the old Wilmingtonian hotel into a boutique neighborhood hotel, including Dram Yard and Gazebo Bar with a courtyard and firepits. Being Wilmington's first boutique hotel, the ownership of ARRIVE felt a responsibility to provide an environment that would be unforgettable. No expense was spared when it came to interior appointments, including retro furniture and hardwood floors. All exterior elements required Historic Preservation Commission's approval from the courtyard grounds to every detail of the buildings that make up the hotel. The design also brought back original storefront windows and doors of what is now the Dram Yard Restaurant and returned the former convent building back to its original glory.
