## Paneled Houses & Ruined Temples

One immutable truth about living in a house is that there is always maintenance, upkeep, and improvements that need to be done. How easily those things are accomplished are directly tied to two things. The first factor is the skill and experience of the ones who live there to take care of the issue themselves. The second factor is the availability of financial resources to either pay for the materials to do the job or to pay someone to do the job for you. Either way it requires a commitment of time, effort, and finances.

We just recently studied the book of Haggai where we find the Israelites have been back in Jerusalem for 15 years after being allowed to leave Babylon after 50 years of exile. They were allowed to go back home to rebuild their city, their lives, but especially their temple and the worship of the one true God.

However, this book begins with a charge and a question from God that 2,500 years later is still relevant to us today. God says through Haggai “These people say the time is not right to rebuild the house of God.” Then God poses the following question through Haggai, “Is it time for you yourselves to live in your paneled houses while my temple lies in ruins?” Essentially what God says to
