

## *Heart of Spain: featuring Corpus Christi in Toledo*



The **Toledo Diocesan Choir** will embark on a 10 day tour of Spain from **May 29-June 7, 2021**. A highlight of the tour is rare opportunity to visit Toledo, Spain for the Feast of Corpus Christi. The celebration of this Holy Day in Toledo is one of the most ancient observances and annually attracts a large number of pilgrims. Following the celebration of Mass in the cathedral, the ornate monstrance containing the Blessed Sacrament is carried in procession through the streets of the old city accompanied by representatives young and old of numerous local and international religions organizations.



The choir will be ambassadors of Toledo, Ohio as the two cities celebrate the 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the **Association of Two Toledos**, the oldest sister city relationship in the world.

The tour will include several days in Barcelona with visits to the magnificent Sagrada Familia Basilica as well as an excursion to the Abbey of Santa Maria de Montserrat where you will hear the famed Escolania boys choir.



The days in Madrid will include visits to the famous Prado museum, the Royal Palace and excursions to El Escorial and Avila, home of St. Teresa.
