

## Terms and Conditions

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Holy Land Travel Center shall be referred to as HLTC within this document.

**DOCUMENTS:** US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies. Passports must be valid for six months after the date of departure.

**REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT:** Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by HLTC. A second payment of \$1249 is required on or before 10/15/2020. Final payment is due 5/1/2021. Late payments are subject to \$50 late fee. HLTC reserves the right to cancel reservations that are not paid 30 days prior to departure and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

**INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS:** Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after HLTC receives your signed cancellation, HLTC will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule:

In addition to any fees/penalties assessed by airlines or hotels, the following charges apply:

- 1) Minimum cancellation fee is \$100 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.
- 2) From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$200.
- 3) From 59 days to 8 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$300 plus any non-refundable amounts paid to and/or penalties assessed by airlines, hotels, or other suppliers of travel services (up to the total cost of the tour).
- 4) From 7 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

**PASSENGER TRAVEL PROTECTION PROGRAM (HIGHLY RECOMMENDED):** Passenger Travel protection program is administered by Travel Guard. Holy Land Travel center is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident and/or illness. For protection, it is important that you have adequate insurance to cover these possibilities. To purchase travel insurance, please send a separate check in the amount of \$195 to the Holy Land Travel Center. Travel insurance is added to each invoice for traveler convenience, but is not a required purchase. Travel insurance takes effect from the time payment is received. All Protection Plan fees are non-refundable. For Pre-Existing Medical Conditions Exclusion Waiver, insurance plan must be purchased within 15 days of Initial Trip Payment.

**MEDICAL CONDITION:** We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our travelers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. HLTC is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior, during, or after travel.

**LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS:** By private deluxe motor coach (air-conditioned).

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge added to the invoice. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost of \$750.

**MEALS:** Breakfast and dinner daily in accordance with itinerary. All beverages are extra. Dinner on the day of arrival day and breakfast on the last day will be included pending final flight schedules and availability.

**TIPPING:** The price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the Tour Guide and Motor Coach Driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each; Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be precollected before pilgrimage for traveler convenience, but it will be decided as a group closer to departure.

*Note: While no changes are anticipated, there may be unforeseen occasions when certain alterations become necessary, either due to changes to the airline schedule or any other reason. All Masses are subject to local church schedules and substitution with alternate Mass sites if churches mentioned are not available. Holy Land Travel Center reserves the right to change the itinerary due to such unforeseen circumstances or emergencies.*

**AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH:** Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing **non-refundable, non-amenable** tickets for groups flying together for the entire itinerary. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from such occurrences. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

**SEAT ASSIGNMENT:** THERE IS NO ADVANCE SEAT SELECTION FOR TOUR DEPARTURES. Note that "bulkhead" and "exit row" seats are assigned by the carrier at the airport. HLTC can not guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline and are pending availability. Though not guaranteed, early check-in is recommended to secure seats with travel companion.

**BAGGAGE:** International flights to and from the USA allow the passenger to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage on domestic flights will cost extra. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations.

**PRICES:** All prices are based on exchange rates and fares applicable at time of quotation and based on minimum number of paying passengers stated in the brochure, and are therefore subject to change if fares change (including fuel surcharges increase), if group does not reach minimum or if exchange rates fluctuate. Minimum number of paying passengers is 20.

**NOT INCLUDED:** Passport and Visas, meals not mentioned, beverages with meals, extra beyond standard menu, excess baggage, luggage on domestic flights, telephone calls, fuel surcharges increase.

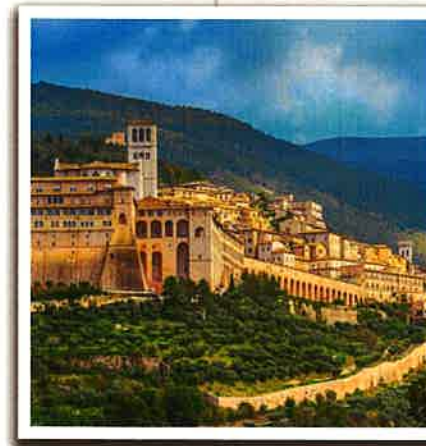

### Day by Day Itinerary

**JULY 5 DAY 1: DEPARTURE:** Depart for your overnight flight to Rome, with meals and beverages served aloft. at leisure to explore the lovely town with its quaint streets and alleys. We continue to Rome for dinner and overnight.

**JULY 6 DAY 2: ROME:** Upon arrival at the airport, meet your HLTC representative and immediately start our pilgrimage by visiting St Peter's Basilica. Time for lunch before we head to our hotel for overnight. Overnight: Rome (B, D)

**JULY 7 DAY 3: ROME:** This morning we visit the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. Continue with a visit of the Basilica of St. John Lateran and the Holy Stairs, and the Basilica of St. Mary Major. This afternoon we will have time to spend at Campo De Fiori Market. This evening is free to have an authentic dinner on your own at a local restaurant of your choice. Overnight: Bethlehem (B, D)

**JULY 8 DAY 4: ASSISI / ROME:** Today we leave Rome and head to Assisi in the Umbria's region. Upon arrival we visit the sites of Assisi, birthplace of St. Francis, including the Basilica of Santa Maria Degli Angeli (Our Lady of the Angels). Inside this Basilica, we explore the Portiuncola, the chapel of the Transitus and the Rose Garden. We continue to the Basilica of St. Clare, the Town Hall Square and the Basilica of St. Francis. We enjoy an afternoon at leisure to explore the lovely town with its quaint streets and alleys. We continue to Rome for dinner and overnight. Overnight: Bethlehem (B, D)

**JULY 9 DAY 5 ROME / HOLY LAND:** This morning we head to Rome international airport for our flights to Tel Aviv. Upon arrival we are met by our HLTC representative before we continue to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**JULY 10 DAY 6 BETHLEHEM: EIN KAREM, CHURCH OF THE VISITATION, SHEPHERD'S FIELDS, CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY:** On our first day in the Holy Land we present an overview for a better understanding of its geography and some of the key sites surrounding the area and what makes it such a unique area to the three major religions – Judaism, Christianity and Islam. We then head to the village of Ein Karem, the birthplace of St John the Baptist and to the Church of Visitation where the Blessed Virgin Mary visited her cousin, Elizabeth, and proclaimed the 'Magnificat'. In the afternoon we drive to the Shepherd's Fields where the angels announced the birth of Jesus. Then we visit the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem that stands upon the site where Jesus was born. Overnight: Bethlehem (B, D)

**JULY 11 DAY 7 ARRIVAL: GALILEE: CAESAREA, HAIFA, STELLA MARIS, BAHAI GARDENS:** After breakfast, we head to Caesarea by the Sea to visit the Roman Crusader remains before we continue to Haifa. Upon arrival in Haifa, we will visit Stella Maris, a Carmelite Monastery with the Madonna of Mt Carmel. Next, we stop at the Baha'i Gardens, which includes a staircase of nineteen terraces extending all the way up the northern slope of Mount Carmel. We then continue to our hotel in Nazareth.

**JULY 12 DAY 8 THE MINISTRY OF CHRIST IN THE GALILEE: TIBERIAS, BOAT RIDE ON SEA OF GALILEE, CAPERNAUM, MT. BEATITUDES, MAGDALA CENTER, CAESAREA PHILIPPI:** Some of today's highlights are a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum to see the synagogue and St Peter's house, a visit to the Mount of the Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount was given, to Tabgha to see the splendid mosaic about the miracle of the loaves and fishes, and to the nearby Church of Peter's Primacy where Peter was told " Feed my lambs, feed my sheep." There will be an unforgettable Mass near the shores of the Sea of Galilee at the Primacy or Mt Beatitudes. Next, we head the Magdala Center, the village of Mary Magdalene, where we visit the newly built church on site and the newly excavated ruins. In the afternoon we visit Caesarea Philippi, the location of the testimony of St. Peter and where Jesus answered him "You are the Rock and upon this rock I will build my Church."

Overnight: Nazareth (B, D)

**JULY 13 DAY 9 GALILEE: CANA, NAZARETH, BASILICA OF THE ANNUNCIATION, MOUNT TABOR:** After breakfast, we drive to Cana, where couples will have the opportunity to renew wedding vows. We continue to the Basilica of Annunciation where we will celebrate Mass. Next, we enjoy a visit to Joseph's carpentry shop. This afternoon, we head to Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration. Continue to Bethlehem.

**JULY 14 DAY 10 JERUSALEM, THE PASSION OF JESUS' LAST HOURS: MT OLIVES, PALM SUNDAY, DOMINUS FLEVIT, GETHSEMANE, CAVE OF ASSUMPTION, LAST SUPPER, DAVIDS TOMB, PATER NOSTER, PALACE OF CAIAPHAS:** We begin our day with a visit to the Mount of Olives where Jesus prayed, continue to the Chapel of Ascension where Jesus ascended into heaven. Next, we visit the church of Pater Noster where Jesus taught the disciples the Lord's Prayer. Next, we walk the Palm Sunday road, stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. Then to Gethsemane, the Rock of Agony where Jesus prayed His last prayer before his arrest. Next, we head to Mount Zion, visiting the cave of Assumption (Dormition Abbey) of Mary to heaven. We visit the room of the Last Supper, King David's Tomb, and the Church of St. Peter Gallicantu, where Peter denied Jesus three times. We end our day visiting the Palace of Caiaphas, home of the corrupt Jewish high priest. We enjoy dinner and overnight at our hotel.

**JULY 15 DAY 11 THE WAY OF THE CROSS: VIA DOLOROSA, ST ANNE'S CHURCH, ECCE HOMO, CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHER, NOTRE DAME CENTER:** After breakfast we head to Jerusalem and start our visit with St Anne Church (the traditional birthplace of the Virgin Mary). Continue to view the Sisters of Zion, Ecco Homo where Pilate proclaimed "Behold the man." Next, we retrace the last steps of Jesus as we walk along the Via Dolorosa (Way of Sorrow), through the markets of the Old City praying the Stations of the Cross at each station shrine, we reflect on the greatness of His sacrifice. Finally, we arrive at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre for Mass. Free time on our own at the old city and time for shopping at the Franciscan store. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

**JULY 16 DAY 12 RETURN TO THE US:** Today we bid farewell to the Holy Land and will remember our pilgrimage for a lifetime.
