Our convictions

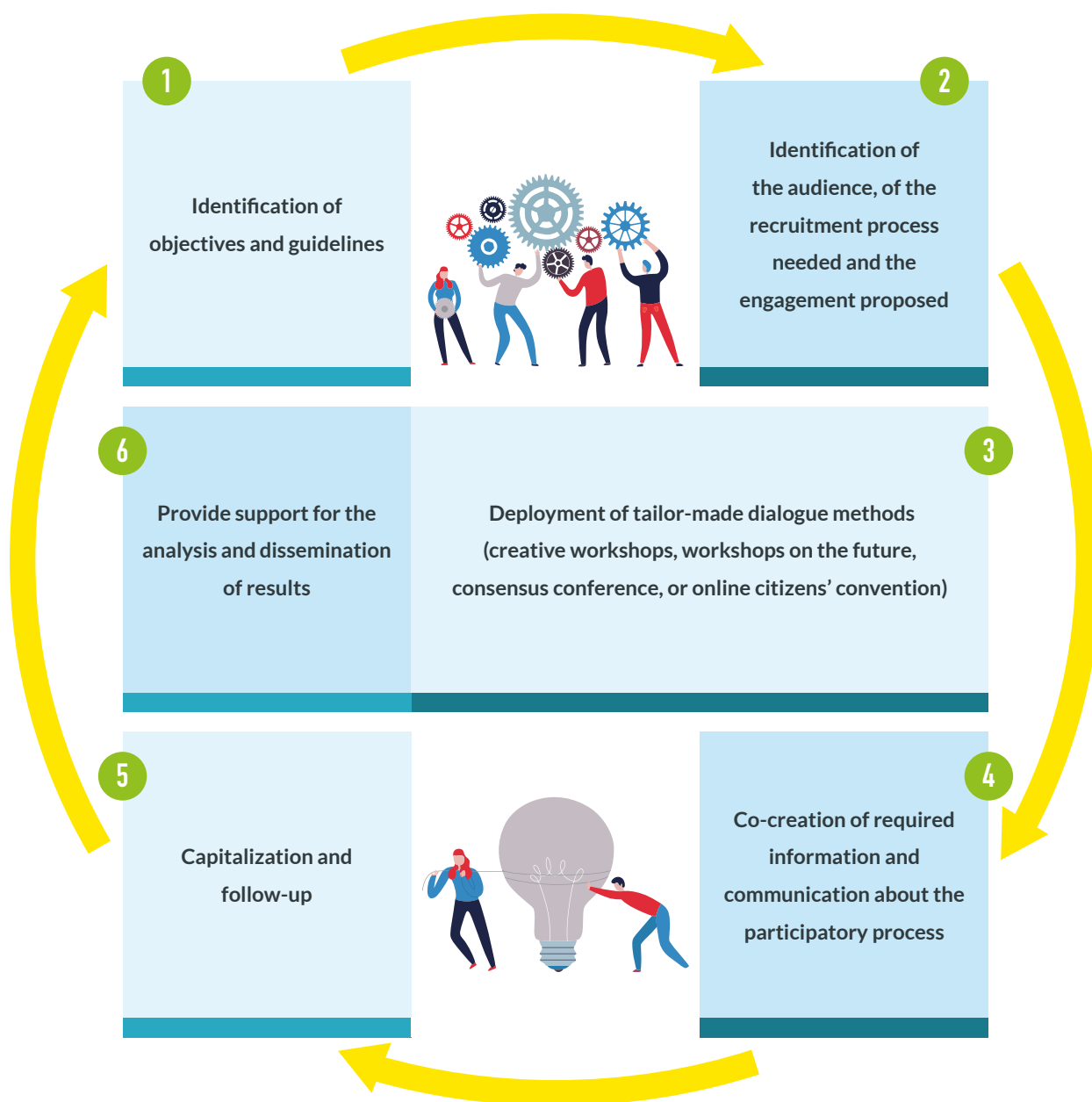
No subject is too complex or too divisive to be discussed with citizens and stakeholders. Making it possible to express and listen to divergent opinions is the basis for dialogue.

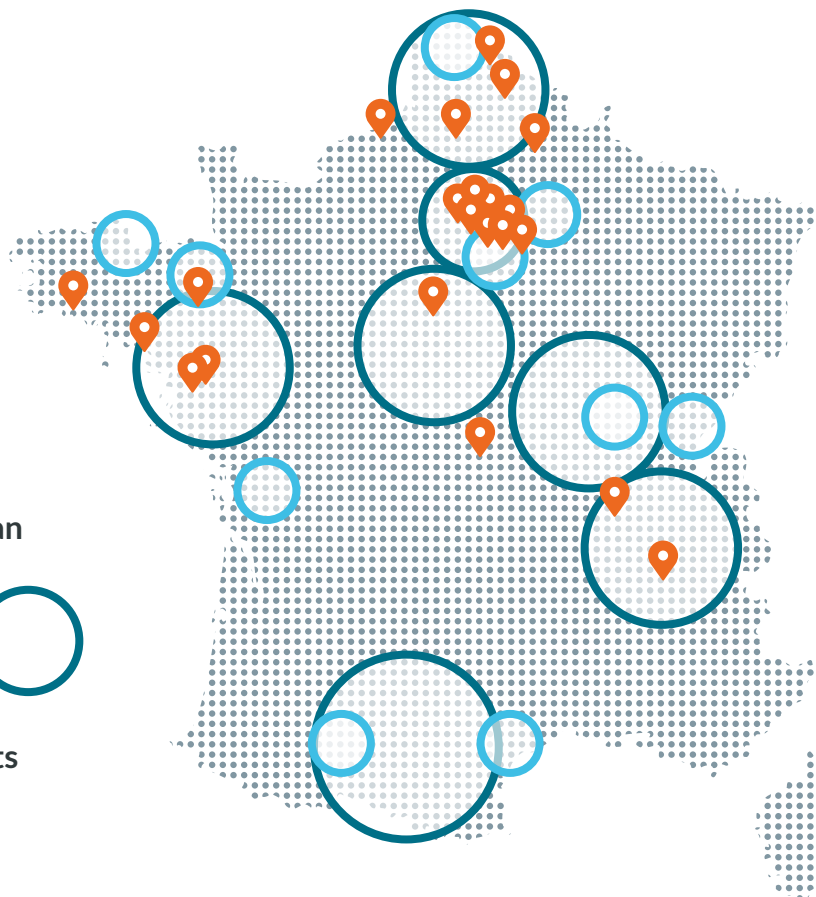

The local Citizens' Convention of Est Ensemble

Animation of the Local Citizens' Convention for the climate of Est Ensemble, a community bringing together 9 municipalities of Seine-Saint-Denis (430,000 inhabitants). 100 citizens randomly selected to submit to officials to fight against global warming and preserve biodiversity in a spirit of social justice.

The APF France handicap Citizens' Debate

Animation of the citizen's debate made up for half of the members of the organisation, half of external citizens. The objective: make proposals in the context of the French presidential election on "social protection: what model for tomorrow?" The reflections are integrated into the network's advocacy actions and in the framework of its associative project.

The Citizens' Convention Nantes Metropole

Animation of the 1st citizens' convention organized on the scale of a metropolitan area (24 municipalities, 65,000 inhabitants) over 5 months. 80 citizens invited to reflect on the impact of the health crisis on their lives and the region.

The final recommendations were processed by the services of Nantes Métropole and officials.

The Citizens' Convention for the climate

Co-design and co-facilitation of the first nation-wide citizens' convention. 150 citizens drawn by lot to develop proposals to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by at least 40% by 2030, in a spirit of social justice. 9 months of work, 149 proposals submitted to the Ministry of Ecological Transition.

Organization of the European citizen debate on space in 22 European countries, management of a coalition of partners. 1,600 participants

Global citizen debate on climate and energy

Initiator of the “WWViews climate and energy”, a global dialogue to prepare the follow-up of the Paris Agreement. 76 countries on 5 continents, 10,000 participants.

Program coordinated with the Danish Board of Technology Foundation, the secretariat of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (CNUCC – UNFCCC) and the National and the Commission nationale du débat (CNDP).

The Conference on the Future of Europe

Codesign and co-host the Citizens' Panels of the Conference on the future of Europe. Objective: to integrate the voice of citizens to build the Europe of tomorrow. In total, 800 citizens from the 27 EU countries are debating in 24 languages on various themes (values, institutions, climate, health migration, etc.).

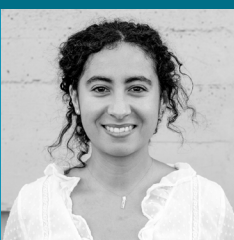

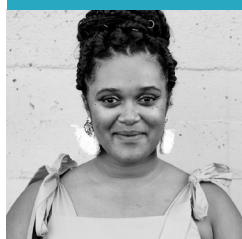
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
