WP Slideshow Master is a plugin that is used to create a slideshow within the content of a page / post. With the various options provided by this plugin, slideshow creation process becomes easier.

Note: This plugin comes in two variants: Full Edition and Lite Edition. The Lite Edition does not include the following features that are available in the Full Edition.

1. Slideshow Promo
2. Limiting amount of the slide box into maximum 6
3. Button Share
4. Slideshow layout option
5. Animation & Audio option
6. Popup Detail Position option

Here's a detailed explanation on how to use the plugin.

A. ANATOMY OF WP SLIDESHOW MASTER

Within this plugin, a slideshow will consist of the following:

1. Container Slideshow
2. Slide Box
3. Style

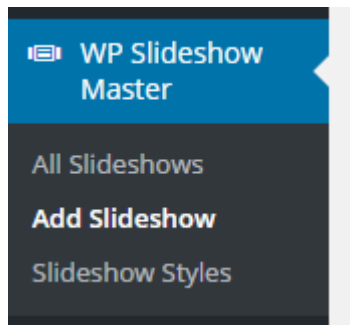
To create a slideshow, you must properly set the various options of each object mentioned above. The settings are described further in the succeeding paragraphs.

B. MANAGING SLIDESHOW

B.1. Creating a New Slideshow

To create a new slideshow, please follow the steps below.

1. Click the "Add Slideshow" Menu item found at the left side menu of the WordPress Dashboard.



2. Basic settings available are described further as follows:

1. Slideshow Name -- Specifies the name of the slideshow. This data will not be used directly in slideshow form but only to identify the slideshow from among other slide shows.

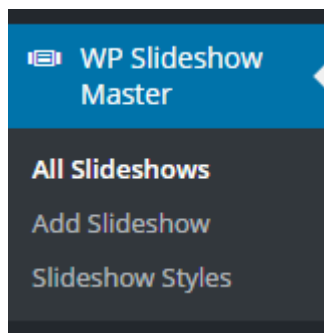
3. Please click the Add Slideshow to complete the initial settings of the newly created slideshow.

You will then be taken to a page that allows you to set the slideshow's other options further. This will be explained in more detail in the next section.

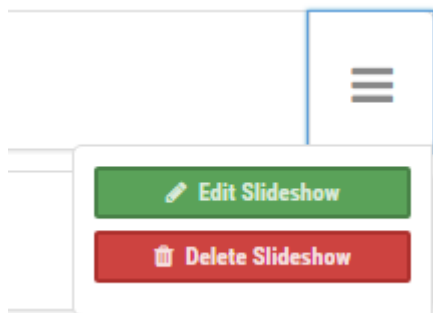
B.2. Changing Settings Slideshow

To change the slideshow settings, please take the following steps:

1. Access the slideshow detail page via the "All Slideshows" link found in the sidebar of the WordPress Admin Dashboard.



2. In the Slideshow List, focus on one item and click the right button. In the sub menu that pop-up, click the Edit Slideshow button.



3. On the Edit page please change the data and settings according to your preferences and then save the data by clicking the "Save Change" button.

The various options and settings can be set on the edit page and discussed in detail below.

I. The General Tab

This section contains the basic options for slideshow.

1. Slideshow Name -- Specifies the name of the slideshow. This data will

not be used directly in slideshow form but only to identify the slideshow from among other slide shows.

1. Replacement Slideshow -- Ses a replacement slideshow, which is shown in the promo.

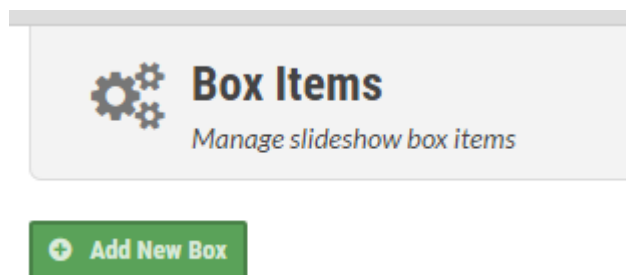

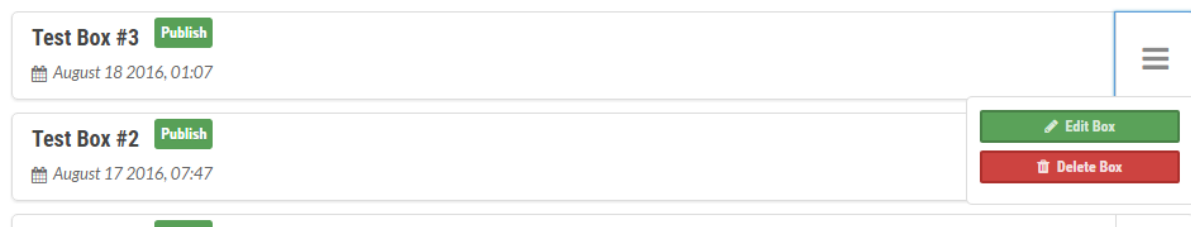
III. The Box Items Tab

In this section you can set slider box options that will be displayed in the slideshow.

To add a slider box you can use the Add New Box.

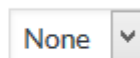
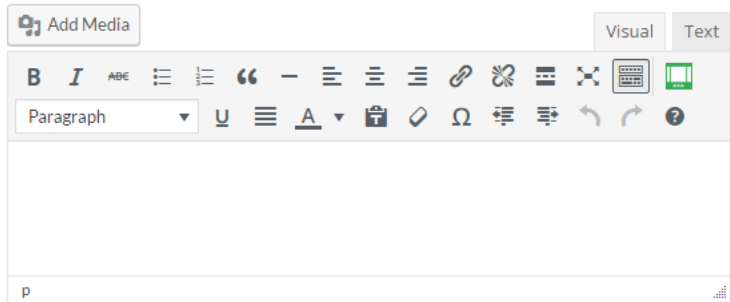


Meanwhile, if you want to change or remove the slider box you can use the action button on every list box.



The Edit Box button will modify the slider box setting whose options are explained below.


1. Title -- Specifies the title of the slider box.




a. If you select Image, then the options that you must specify, among others:



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IV. The Statistics Tab

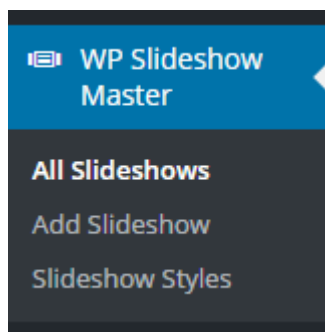
It is in this section where you can see the statistics of user activity on the slideshow display. Statistical data presented in this section include:

1. How many slideshows viewed by the user
2. How many users see details of media
3. How many users who viewed the content details box
4. How many users share content through social media slideshow

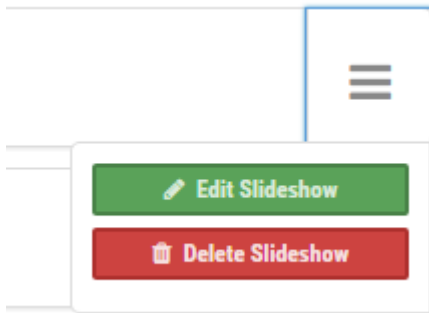
B.3. Removing Slideshow

To remove the slideshow, it can be done with the following steps:

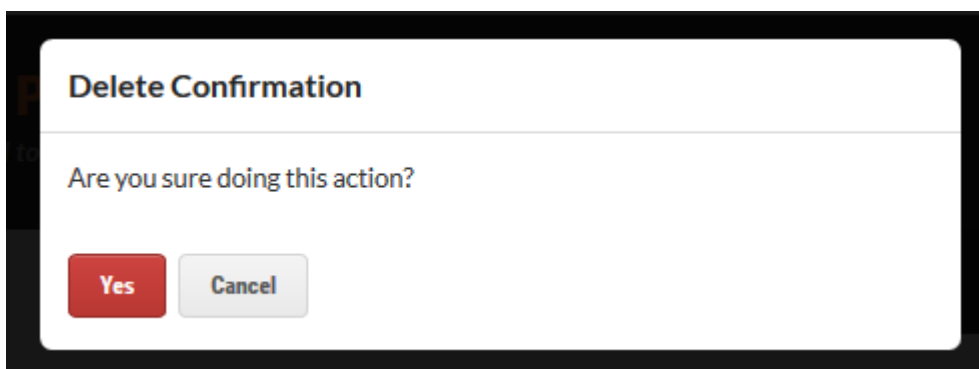
1. Access the slideshow detail page via the "All Slideshows" which found in the Menu Link at the Sidebar of the WordPress Admin Dashboard.



2. In the Slideshow List, focus on one item and click the right button. In the sub menu that pops up, click the Delete Slideshow button.



3. There will be the prompt that appears before the system completely delete the data. Click Yes to remove and Cancel to cancel the deletion process.



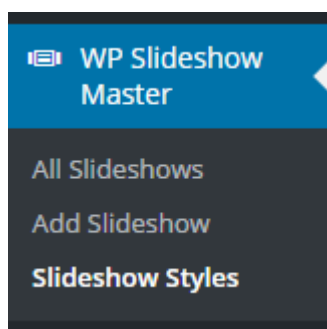
C. MANAGING STYLE SLIDESHOW

Style is a data object that contains settings that determine how the slideshow is displayed and determine the effects of the slideshow.

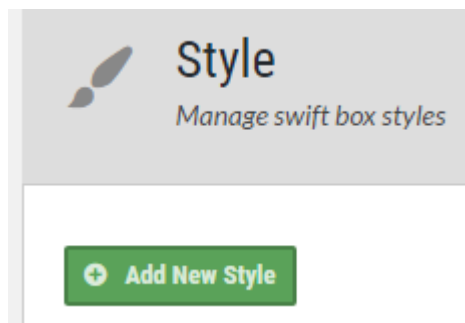
C.1. Creating a New Style

To create a new slideshow, please take the following steps:

1. Access the page style management via the "Slideshow Styles" which you can see at the Sidebar of the WordPress Admin Dashboard.



2. On Style Management Page, click the Add New Style button.



3. Enter some basic data or settings, as follows:

1. Style Name -- Specifies the name of style. This data will not be used directly in the style but only serves as a name to identify the style from among others.

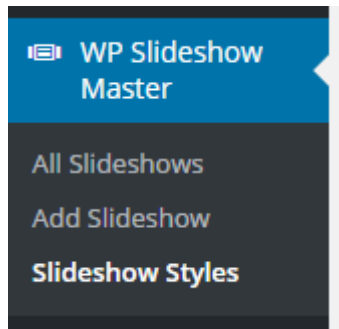

After the data is saved you will be taken to a page alteration style to set more options. This will be explained in more detail in the next section.

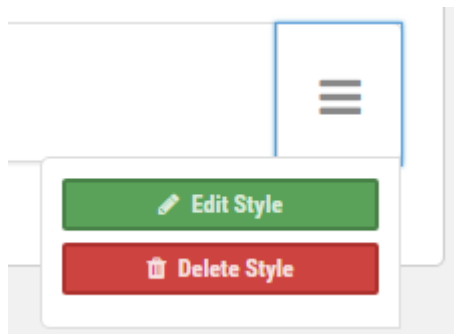
C.2. Changing Style Settings

To change the style settings, please take the following steps:

1. Access the Style Management Page via the "Slideshow Styles" menu link found at the sidebar of the WordPress Admin Dashboard.



2. In the list of existing styles, focus on one item and click the right button. In the sub menu that pops up, click the Edit Style button.



3. On the Edit page please change the data and settings according to your preference and then to save the data click the "Save Change" button.
