This machine was being used to send high grade intelligence including Adolf Hitler's most secret battle plans to his generals. All the staff that worked at Bletchley Park was sworn to absolute secrecy, but now this story can be told, which as historians tell us shortened the war by at least two years and saved countless lives.
