

Community Group Leader - Role Overview

Role: Group leaders equip and facilitate communities of grace to passionately pursue life and mission with Jesus. They are the front line of Gospel transformation which is characterized by *Mission*, *Growth*, *Care*, and *Fellowship* and informed by the *Core Values* of Fellowship Greenville.

Competency

Life with Jesus

- Models a Gospel-transformed life that is above reproach
- Practices a regular rhythm of prayer, study of the Word, and stewardship of life for God's glory and purpose

Life in Community

- Engages as an active member at Fellowship Greenville
- Demonstrates the ability to lead and organize others toward a healthy, Gospel-centered, Community Group

Life on Mission

- Equips individuals for the work of ministry by encouraging and developing their gifts and wiring
- Models sharing the Gospel within their spheres of influence

Description

Mission

- Identify the gifts and wiring of others to further develop them for multiplication of the group
- Encourage and model serving those within their spheres of influence inside and outside the walls of Fellowship Greenville

Growth

- Facilitate group discussions by modeling and promoting participation, vulnerability, and accountability
- Ensure that regular group rhythms of Scripture and prayer are in place and practiced

Care

- Come alongside group members in joy and sorrow, encouraging with the Gospel through all seasons of life
- Connect group members in need of higher levels of care to the appropriate ministries in place at Fellowship Greenville

Fellowship

- Foster an environment of hospitality and relationship for depth and intimacy for those inside and outside the group
- Reach out to potential group members in a timely, respectful manner (3 days)

Commitments

Communication: Respond in a timely manner to establish effective communication between group members, directors, and staff (3 days is considered timely)

Training: Attend all leader trainings and recommended events

Oversight: Connect with appointed **Director** twice each month, one face to face every two months

Group Meeting: Meets a minimum of twice a month with additional gender-specific meetings
