

Process of Multiplication

1. Create a Culture of Multiplication & Discipleship

- Cast the expectation and consistently remind the group
- Use intentional language consistently
- Model multiplication through smaller breakouts
- Celebrate the multiplication of other groups
- Use peoples giftings identify co-leaders

2. Prepare for Multiplication

- Become Healthy
 - We grow as disciples when we multiply, if we multiply when the group isn't healthy then division can be created
 - Consistent participation from core group members
 - Groups are not in crisis (divorce, personal loss,..)
 - Group members are living out their sent identity
- Create Space for Others
 - Through personal and corporate invitation
 - Follow the 4-1-1 Principal for reaching out located in the How To Connect document
 - Cultivate hospitality and a welcoming atmosphere
 - Through specific gatherings designed for invitation
- o Give Co-leaders Increasing Amounts of Responsibility
 - I do, you watch, we talk
 - I do, you help, we talk
 - You do, I help, we talk
 - You do, I watch, we talk
 - Launched as leader
- Decide How You Will Multiply
 - Launching of New Groups
 - Through the Foundations class
 - Through Relengage to Community Group
 - Through the emergence of currently existing groups
 - Birthing of New Groups
 - At least 6 or more people, including the leaders, launch out from an existing group
 - The birthing group commissions the sending group
 - This happens when the new leaders are ready and not when a "max" size is reached
 - Sending Out of Leaders
 - Send a couple out to be leaders of a group
 - Ideally this happens with co-leaders

- Additional people may be added through Foundations and church contact
- Coordinated with FG Community Group staff for group member support
- Establish Future Group Members
 - This is often Spirit led and anchored in geography or relationship
- Pray For Your Current and Future Groups
 - Who will be joining new group
 - When should the new group launch
 - Who do you know that you can invite

3. Multiply

- o Do this when the group is healthy
 - Often seems too slow for leaders and too early for group
- o Do this when the co-leaders are ready, not when groups reach "max" size
- Launch Night Celebration
 - Launch in prayer
 - Launch in joy/celebration
- Weeks leading up to the launch do the Multiplication Curriculum

4. Partner Together

- Have a reunion gathering that is composed of the new group and the old group.
- o Both new groups should start with the vision for groups and multiplication.
- Both the new and old groups revisit the Launch Curriculum to remember the purpose and goal of community groups.
