3 Things in this Passage

1. Jesus is the true King.

Luke 19:37-38

37 As he was drawing near—already on the way down the Mount of Olives—the whole multitude of disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen,

Luke 19:37-38

38 saying, "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

3 Things in this Passage

2. Jesus is not the King you expect.

Luke 19:30-35

30 "Go into the village in front of you, where on entering you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever yet sat. Untie it and bring it here.

31 If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' you shall say this: 'The Lord has need of it.' "

Luke 19:30-35

32 So those who were sent went away and found it just as he had told them.

33 And as they were untying the colt, its owners said to them,

“Why are you untying the colt?”

Luke 19:30-35

34 And they said, "The Lord has need of it."

**35 And they brought it to Jesus,
and throwing their cloaks on the colt,
they set Jesus on it.**

Zechariah 9:9

**9 "Behold, your king comes to you;
righteous and bringing salvation;
humble and riding on a donkey,
on a colt, the foal of a donkey."**







Luke 19:41-44

41 "And when he drew near and saw the city,
he wept over it,

42 saying, "Would that you, even you, had
known on this day the things that make for
peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes.

Luke 19:41-44

43 For the days will come upon you, when your enemies will set up a barricade around you and surround you and hem you in on every side

Luke 19:41-44

44 and tear you down to the ground, you and your children within you. And they will not leave one stone upon another in you, because you did recognize the time of your visitation.
