2018 DUG HAYNESVILLE Conference Highlights



- Technological breakthroughs with longer laterals and improved completion designs have led Chesapeake to roughly 30% production growth in the Haynesville since 2016. VP Tim Beard also pointed to an even brighter future in the play with the possibility for refracks and a recent “monster well” in the Bossier.
- In 2017, Chesapeake’s lateral length was primarily 10,000 ft, with the shortest lateral drilled last year around 7,500 ft. Currently, the company is drilling 15,000-ft laterals, and will continue to extend laterals as it moves across the play.
- BP’s strategy in the Haynesville has been to co-develop both the Haynesville and Bossier reservoirs on a single pad, and to among the deepest depths in the shale world—up to 16,000 ft (4,876 m) TVD—and with laterals that average about 7,500 ft (2,286 m).
- According to BP’s Doug Johnson (senior vice president of Lower 48, East and West Development), the company’s wells have performed favorably compared to many of the play’s other operators. One of BP’s Southern Haynesville wells averaged over 16 million cubic feet per day (MMcf/d) over its 14 months.
- Tellurian’s business model includes construction of the \$15.2 billion Driftwood LNG terminal near Lake Charles on the Calcasieu River, a pipeline network and upstream assets in the Haynesville Shale. The aggregated system is going to deliver up to 4 billion cubic feet per day (Bcf/d) of gas to global markets and has a yearly capacity of 27.6 million tons.
- Castleton began 2018 producing 253 million cubic feet of gas equivalent per day—72% natural gas—from 2,700 gross wells on 163,000 net acres. Proved reserves at year-end 2017 were 1.5 trillion cubic feet equivalent. The company also has a significant in-house midstream operation with 786 miles of high- and low-pressure gathering pipelines, as well as water handling and gas condensate assets.
