

DUG Eagle Ford 2019 Conference Highlights

- Austin Chalk Is Back And Delivering Results "The field started out with vertical drilling, but the big increase in production came when horizontal drilling kicked in in the '90s," Phil Martin, CEO of New Century Exploration, told attendees at the recent Hart Energy DUG Eagle Ford Conference & Exhibition in San Antonio. "And it's produced 300 MMbbl cumulative in its time, which at \$50/bbl, that's \$15 trillion it's generated. That's an awful lot of money, and it's mainly been technology-derived.
- The Eagle Ford Is The 'Dark Horse' Of Shales. The Eagle Ford rig count has been relatively steady compared to other plays through the industry's frequent commodity price upheavals. Drilling times also continue to improve, said Enverus analyst Bernadette Johnson at DUG Eagle Ford.
- **ConocoPhillips executive Erec Isaacson** offered the audience at DUG Eagle Ford several lessons the company has learned during its decade of operating in the basin.
 - "With all of that information what we've been able to do from 2014-2018 is decrease or spud to total depth time by 33%, normalized to 10,000 feet," he told attendees at Hart Energy's DUG Eagle Ford conference and exhibition in San Antonio on Sept. 25. "That puts us at the front of the pack in terms of drilling efficiency as compared to our peer group. We don't stop there with our use of data analytics. We also use it in our completions. We take all of our completion parameters and compare those to how they perform from the production of the well. We end up modifying and continuously optimizing our completions."
- Innovations in well-spacing and stacking have allowed **ConocoPhillips** to achieve a 20% field-level recovery factor in the Eagle Ford Shale, the company's chief technology officer told attendees. The play has areas where the cost of supply is as low as \$20 to \$30 per barrel of oil, said Greg Leveille. Those core areas are where ConocoPhillips is focused.
- SilverBow Resources Inc. works both wet and dry gas areas, and is the Eagle Ford's only public pureplay in dry gas, said Gleeson Van Riet, the company's EVP and CFO. SilverBow has drilled 20 of the top 50 Eagle Ford gas wells and, Van Riet said, the play is the best place to be in the U.S. for natural gas. "It has the best prices, good infrastructure and it's located in the demand growth area," he said during a latemorning panel on natural gas.











ATTENDEE BREAKDOWN


