### Take-A-Seat Program at the Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium Nameplate Wording Guidelines

---

- Wording is limited to 4 lines, 26 characters per line (including punctuation and spaces)
- Wording will be centered on the nameplate
- All wording is upper and lower case, as specified by the donor's plate submission
- Seats may be named for individuals only, not companies or organizations.
