The score is for a jazz band arrangement of 'The Sheik'. It features the following instruments and parts:

- Piano:** Plays a rhythmic accompaniment with chords: Ab9, G9, Ab9 G9, C9, Gm7, C9, Cm7. It plays *f*. There is a 'Solo - As is' section for the piano.
- Bass:** Plays a rhythmic accompaniment with chords: Ab7, G7, Ab7 G7, C7, Gm, C7, Cm. It plays *f*.
- Drums:** Plays a rhythmic accompaniment with a pattern of eighth and sixteenth notes. It plays *f*.
