New Note: F#

Playing Tips:

1. Remember to check the key signature before starting to play each song.
2. Use a tuner and practice keeping the needle still as you play the G Major scale.

Music Terms:

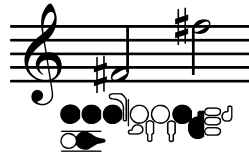
Chromatic: Literally means "all the colors." Chromatic refers to patterns of notes going up or down by 1/2 steps.

New Key Signature:

G Major: All F's are F#

New Scale: G Major

F# (F-sharp)



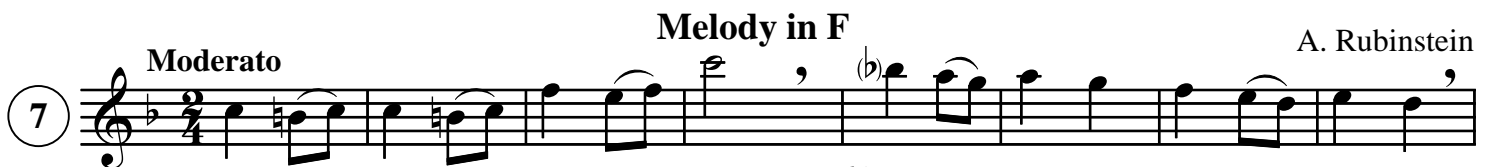
Warm-up and Review in Simple Time:
