About the Composer

James Hook (1746 – 1827) was an English organist and composer. He wrote over thirty stage works, more than 200 songs and countless pieces for harpsichord and piano, one of which is *Menuet*, transcribed here for string orchestra.

A menuet (minuet) is a social dance for two of French origin in $\frac{3}{4}$ time. The word is adapted from the Italian minuetto. meaning, small, pretty and delicate and should be played with these descriptions in mind.

About the Arranger

As a major composer of instrumental and vocal music, Carl Strommen is recognized as one of the most oftenperformed composers of educational music in the United States.

A graduate of the City College of New York, Mr. Strommen was the Director of Bands at the Mamaroneck Public Schools, Mamaroneck, NY for many years. He is a member of the faculty at the CW Post campus of Long Island University, where he teaches orchestration and arranging. Recognized by ASCAP as a consistent writer in the Standard Awards category, Mr. Strommen is also active as a clinician, lecturer and guest conductor.
