A Note From The Composer

Jenkins' Ferry is a national park outside of Sheridan, Arkansas, just off the Saline River. It commemorates the battle of Jenkins Ferry where Union forces successfully crossed the Saline while being attacked by Confederate forces. They were able to cross successfully and later regroup in Little Rock.

Jenkins Ferry concert march is a march that serves as a follow up to Monticello March, which I wrote several years ago and has been quite popular. The instrumentation is the same, using only one clarinet part, one trumpet part and only one tenor line that is played by trombone, baritone, and tenor sax. The clarinet part does not cross the break. The tuba part is doubled in the bass clarinet and bari sax part. The french horn part is never exposed, always doubled in the alto sax. I was very careful to use voicings that make the band sound big with so few parts. This march would be ideal for small junior high school bands.
