- Euph.:** Euphonium. Measures 22-27 have quarter notes, and measure 28 has a half note. Dynamics: *f* in measure 28.
- Tuba:** Tuba. Measures 22-27 have quarter notes, and measure 28 has a half note. Dynamics: *f* in measure 28.
- Cym.:** Cymbal. Measures 22-27 are silent, and measure 28 has a cymbal crash (*cym*) with an accent (*>*). Dynamics: *f* in measure 28.
- Bls.:** Bells. Measures 22-27 are silent, and measure 28 has a half note. Dynamics: *f* in measure 28.
- Drums:** Drums. Measures 22-27 have a steady eighth-note pattern, and measure 28 has a half note with an accent (*>*). Dynamics: *sfz* in measure 28.
