Giovanni Battista Pergolesi (1710-1736) was one of the most successful Italian composers in the early part of the eighteenth century. Although his original family name was Draghi, Giovanni's last name became known as Pergolesi because his ancestors had lived in the town of Pergola. He first studied violin and composition before becoming a conductor and popular composer. With numerous successes, he was appointed vicemaestro at the age of twenty-two to the royal chapel. The stability of that position enabled Pergolesi to compose for the most important families in Naples. After he died of tuberculosis, his fame quickly spread with many productions and printings of his works.

In his brief life of only twenty-six years, Pergolesi completed comic and serious operas and numerous sacred works, including cantatas, masses, oratorios, and psalm settings. He is especially known today for La serva padrona, his most famous comic opera, and Stabat Mater, a setting for treble voices and strings and the most frequently printed work in the eighteenth century.

"Sanctus" and "Agnus Dei" may be performed separately or together as a set. However, they are not part of a singular mass setting of Pergolesi. This edition includes tempo and dynamic indications and an English version of the original Latin text. The keyboard accompaniment, including the four-measure introduction before each movement, has been added by the editor.

Each movement should be performed quite smoothly, always emphasizing the nor-Latin Pronunciation Guide mally stressed syllables indicated by accent marks in the following pronunciation guide.
