

Performance Notes

It was such fun for me to introduce in different voices and then intertwine together these two French carols. They are two of my favorite Christmas songs and I enjoyed throwing the melodies back and forth to different voice parts and then have them all end up together at the conclusion of the piece.

Sing each carol liltingly throughout, sometimes boldly, sometimes more gentle. Make sure to listen carefully during the measures of rests, so there will be continuity of pitch when you enter again on your own part. You might want a little *ritardando* on measure 46, but basses, make sure your last two measures are *a tempo* and very soft. Leave the audience wondering if they actually heard you singing or just imagined it!

Enjoy this piece and have a very blessed Christmas.
