

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## The Arranger

Erik Morales (b. December 10, 1966) began his composing career shortly after graduation from high school in south Florida. He studied composition at Florida International University, and completed his bachelor's degree at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette. Accessible at all levels, the music of Erik Morales has a unique melodic and harmonic vocabulary that appeals to audiences nationwide. His published works encompass a large variety of styles and settings, including works for concert, orchestral, jazz, and chamber ensembles. Mr. Morales currently teaches and plays trumpet professionally in the New Orleans area, in addition to maintaining an active composing and conducting schedule.

## About the Music

This popular Christmas song was written in 1963 by Edward Pola and George Wyle and has since been recorded by many top singers. This string arrangement is augmented with a drum set part which may be omitted if not available. The piece is to be conducted as a waltz style where each measure receives one beat at a moderate tempo. You will notice, that like most waltzes, there is an emphasis on beat two several times throughout the arrangement. This helps to establish the flow that is needed to distinguish the identifiable characteristics of this memorable holiday classic. Although there is a swaying groove, the eighth notes are to remain straight. There are no swing eighths. The rhythm that appears in measure three in the 1<sup>st</sup> Violin is important. This rhythm appears many times throughout the arrangement and should be rehearsed carefully to ensure all musicians have the same interpretation and bowing direction.
