NARRATOR 2 (Gabriel)*:

(begin without music)

With tender emotion the Father spoke to me:

"Go, Gabriel; go and tell Mary."

He will rule Jacob's house forever – there will <u>never</u> be an end to His kingdom!"

(Gabriel) "The Holy Spirit will come upon you.

The power of the Highest will hover over you;

therefore, the Child you bring to birth will be called Holy, Son of God.

Nothing, you see, is impossible with God."

(Mary) "Yes, I see it all now: I'm the Lord's maid, ready to serve.

Let it be with Me just as you say."
