#### **NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR**

Patapan Fantasy is designed for students halfway through their first year in band. It has been written using just the first handful of notes presented in most beginning band methods and without a written key signature.

There are percussion parts for five players, however, if you have additional percussionists, you can add extra students on the snare drum part using toms, bongos, or other drums. The last note in the gong/suspended cymbal should be dampened on beat one of measure 44.
