NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Arranged for your vocalist, *Night and Day* is presented here as a bossa nova. At the indicated tempo, ♩ = 80 BPM, the band should have a relaxed feel but play on top of the straight eighth-note beat. Please observe dynamics, especially behind the vocalist! After the mf intro, bring the level down to p behind the vocal. Backgrounds should always be subordinate to the vocal. The overall chart dynamic is mf until f at the ensemble section, starting with the sax soli at m. 73, then back down behind vocal again as indicated. Climax dynamically at m. 105 with ff at the key change, then immediately back down to mf again behind the vocal and out.

RHYTHM SECTION

Each member of the rhythm section has a specific part to play in Latin music. The players should listen closely to each other and lock in with each other to create a joyous, lilting feeling.

Guitar—From the first measure, the guitarist plays the eighth-note pattern, which continues throughout the whole chart. As simple as it seems, this is one of the most important parts of the Latin feel. Play lightly with a full strum and steady time.

Piano—Play the written part or embellish on the chord progression, but always maintain a strict tempo. The left hand doubles the bass throughout. Avoid overplaying, which can often create musical clutter.

Bass—Play the written part simply with a firm, steady feel. Always listen and lock in the time with the other rhythm players.

Drums—The pattern at the beginning carries throughout the whole chart, with cross-stick playing the clave pattern on snare rim. Begin on closed hi-hat, switch to ride cymbal at m. 57, then back to hi-hat at m. 113. Play lightly to keep the tempo moving.

HORNS

Play lightly on top of the beat to maintain forward motion and always pay close attention to intonation, especially on unison passages—for example, the saxes at m. 16 and m. 49, the trumpets at m. 23, and the trombones at m. 56. Observe articulations to achieve clean unisons and tight ensembles. Trumpets should have cup mutes if possible.

VOCAL SOLOIST

The vocal range is from F below middle C to third-line B natural. The vocalist should study the song (there are numerous recordings online by many of the greatest singers of all time) and practice with the piano player to become comfortable with the melody. This may allow some freedom for personal expression. The vocalist must hear the key change at m. 105 and carry the melody with confidence. At mm. 108–109 the descending melody line on an E major scale is doubled in the piano part. Strive for good intonation always!
