PROGRAM NOTES

A Tender Moment in Time is a musical snapshot of the emotions experienced living through a delicate time in one's life, whether it be fear, joy, sadness, hope, etc. For me personally, this piece illustrates my own struggle with moving away from family members that I lived near for several decades. The opening of the piece highlights fear and uncertainty with the use of harmonics in the violins and violas, as well as sparse orchestration and pauses (mm. 1–15). Each following section in the music depicts optimism (main melody mm. 16–26), determination (mm. 27–41), sadness (mm.44–46), joy (mm. 56–68), and hope (mm. 60–68).

As you perform this piece, be sure that every phrase is played thoughtfully and expressively, adding vibrato where appropriate, and with smooth bow changes. Pay attention to dynamic contrasts and balance throughout the piece so that the melodic line always shines through.
