## **PROGRAM NOTES**

Honor the Brave, by Victor López, is an original composition dedicated to all veterans who have served honorably on active duty in the Armed Forces. It celebrates those men and women who have made the ultimate sacrifice and who have courageously played an essential role in shaping our country and ensuring the freedom that we enjoy.

## NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

This piece has been written using only the first six notes of the D major scale. The introduction should be played courageously. Beginning at measure 5, the staccato notes should be played lightly and with a steady pulse. The cello, string bass, and the left hand of the piano have the first melody at measure 7. Note that the melody is intertwined throughout. Always remember to bring out the melody.

Please note that optional piano and percussion parts have been written to complement the piece, both harmonically and rhythmically. Please feel free to use any light-sounding hand percussion.

I know that your students and audience will enjoy *Honor the Brave* as it has been specifically written for very beginning string orchestras. An excellent opener and appropriate way to celebrate those veterans who have served honorably on active duty in the Armed Forces.
