

# SYMPHONIC STORIES

This piece was written in honor of Meredith Sullivan Boyan, whom I worked with for more than a decade during my nearly 30 years of teaching. She courageously fought a long battle with breast cancer, and while she is no longer with us, her love for music, education, learning, and humanity will continue through the lives of her students, friends, and family.

The title, *Symphonic Stories*, can be interpreted very broadly because all music can tell a story, and each story is personal to the listener and/or performer. My connection with this piece represents some of the stories from our years of working very closely together. Meredith's primary instrument was the saxophone, but as a person who thrived on learning, she was an incredible performer on the flute, clarinet, and even the oboe. She also tackled brass instruments with great competence and, of course, percussion as well. In addition to all the teaching that took place in the music wing, there were countless times I can remember bringing her to tears with laughter, which brought me great joy as well. She was a fierce educator, a passionate student advocate, and, above all, a kind and thoughtful human being.

*Symphonic Stories* begins reflectively, with the percussion instruments representing those times we spent in the band room working on technique, discussing pedagogy, or just having fun. Following the opening, the wind players enter with a resounding chord, followed by alto saxophone and flute solos. Under the solos, all available wind and percussion players softly sing “ahh” on a concert Eb. This is a nod to the outstanding vocalist Meredith was as well. The high point of the first section of the piece is measure 29, with a majestic statement based on a variation of the alto saxophone solo that preceded it. This impact represents the tour de force educator and the power of the impact she had on the lives of the people that surrounded her. Once this section works its way into a resolution, the musical story shifts from reflective and deep emotion to joyful and celebratory. Measure 44 starts the  $\frac{12}{8}$  groove, introduced by the percussion section. Once the clarinets enter with the melody, we are off and running on an adventure.

The story from here to the end of the work represents the many happy memories we shared, whether through student achievements, trips to Disney, or the day-to-day laughter and smiles that filled the room. There is a contrasting melodic section in  $\frac{6}{4}$  starting at measure 82, which is a short moment of reflection or pause in the action, but soon enough we are back on our storytelling adventure, ultimately leading to a powerful ending that includes a melodic quote from the opening section. Just like life, music weaves together highs and lows, tension and release, but in the end, we are left with a feeling of wholeness and satisfaction. This piece is not only to share Meredith’s stories but also for students and teachers to reflect on their own. Our stories are not finished being written, and neither is Meredith’s.
