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
NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

This arrangement of this traditional holiday carol has a variety of articulations which should be executed equally by all players. Doo (‐), Dah (➢), Dit (•), Daht (▲).

1. There is a very repetitive syncopation figure that is commonly written and played in this piece (in mm. 7, 10, 11, and so on). The director may want to rehearse in unison with the entire group to clarify and save some rehearsal time. A variation of this syncopated rhythm appears in mm. 26, 48, 51, 52, and 106. This variation is to emphasize the up beats in those measures.
2. Throughout the piece there are indications for a "4-beat feel" and a "2-beat feel." One obvious difference is for the 4-beat feel, the bass and drums will play on all four beats of a measure, while in the 2-beat, the emphasis will be on beats 1 and 3. Typically for the drumset player, the 4-beat feel uses a ride cymbal where 2-beat often uses the hi-hat. Feel free to experiment with this concept as it offers a nice contrast in the arrangement.
3. At mm. 43–45, note the indication "straight" in the alto saxes and the optional flute and clarinet. Simply play the eighth notes even (not swung) as you would in a classical piece.
4. I made a few indications of "-2" or "-3" over certain notes. This simply means to cut off the note precisely on that beat. The clean abrupt cut-off will emphasize the next rhythmic entrance and help the band sound more mature.
5. You may want to go over the A♭ major or (F minor) scale to introduce the key change at m. 89. There are several D♭s in the trombones and rhythm section, which could surprise the young players.
6. The modulation begins one measure before m. 89 and features the trombone section on the one thing they can do that none of the other instruments can do: glissando from low C to middle F. To be most effective, it is important that the low C clearly begins on beat 2, and the gliss reaches the F right on beat 1 of m. 89.
7. At m. 89, the whole band can really light up with energy as the "shout chorus" has a resemblance of a Dixieland band for eight measures then contrasts quickly to a legato saxophone/flute/clarinet section at m. 97.
8. The last two measures are intended to be a drum solo, or better yet, with the option of the piano and/or vibes playing the chromatic run along with the drum triplets. The very last note needs to be very strong, and I would recommend a cowbell and/or choked splash cymbal.
9. Every soloist has an opportunity in the last two measures of their solo to play as written or...improvise or make a favorite sound or trill or whatever. Have fun!
