NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Proove Your Groove is a medium-slow funky chart with memorable melodies, hip harmonies, and rhythms that will make a body move. To achieve the proper feel and groove, the rhythm section members should stick to the script and remain rhythmically solid without being influenced by the horn players' sense of time. At the same time, the horn players should absolutely listen to the rhythm section to ensure that their rhythms are grounded in the sixteenth-note grid being established.

Tongue stops are appropriate on beat 4 of mm. 3, 7, and 9, as well as later iterations of those same rhythms. That technique will add to the excitement and tightness of the ensemble. In mm. 12 and 16 (and beyond), the scoops can be interpreted as grace notes in the saxophones and trumpets. Trombone 1, of course, will scoop these notes.

It will be important not to be lazy on the staccato notes, especially during melodic passages—play them short! Similarly, on the bridge that begins at mm. 18 and 46, rhythm section members should also be true to the staccatos.

During the trombone solo that begins in m. 38, the guitar, piano, and bass players can add rhythms and/fills on any chord that lasts more than 2 beats, like measures 38, 39, and 41. This will help support the trombone soloist and keep the music moving forward. Just make sure it all grooves by staying in the rhythmic pocket.

Born and raised in a small town in Southwestern Pennsylvania, Alan Baylock has composed music that is performed throughout the world. One of the most respected and sought-after jazz composers and educators in the industry today, he is the director of the Grammy-nominated One O'Clock Lab Band at the University of North Texas, and previously served 20 years as Chief Arranger for the USAF Airmen of Note in Washington, D.C. The Alan Baylock Jazz Orchestra recorded three critically acclaimed CDs and performed throughout the United States for 15 years. Baylock graduated from Shenandoah University (B.M. '90), where he later became Jazz Composer-in-Residence, and the University of North Texas (M.M. '94).

Baylock travels extensively as guest conductor and clinician, and has been featured with close to 100 professional, collegiate, high school (all-state and regional), and middle school jazz ensembles. Alan is on faculty at the National Jazz Workshop (NJW) and directed the NJW All-Star Big Band in performances on the East and West Coast. He is an active member of the Jazz Education Network and is a strong advocate for women in jazz. In 2022, Alan teamed up with composer/arranger Annie Booth to establish Brava Jazz Publishing, whose mission it is to support and champion women composers and arrangers in the field of big band jazz by creating a platform for their music to be widely published and distributed.

Baylock lives in Denton, Texas with his wife, cellist Maria Baylock. In his spare time, Alan enjoys playing table tennis and golfing with his UNT Jazz colleagues.
