## NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

In the opening measures 1-9, keep the percussion and Trumpet at one dynamic level while the woodwinds fade dynamically as if breathing slowly and deep underneath the melodic parts.


In measures 11-12 the Mark Tree should ascend from large to small bars on the downbeat and release on the attack of the Triangle on the following downbeat.

The mallet instruments at measures 30-32 should be played boldly, creating momentum to achieve a sense of arrival at measure 32. The wind instruments’ crescendo supports this idea, but the mallet instruments should be the focus here.

The tempo can push and pull to create a slight feeling of rubato but do not lose the forward momentum of the piece by overdoing it. It works best at the end of phrases.
