
PROGRAM NOTES

For an effective performance of **Skeleton Dance** it is important to observe the dynamics and articulations throughout. In m. 5, the flutes carry the melody. Make sure that the woodwind parts do not cover the flute. M. 8 should be played strongly, and then back to piano in the next measure. M. 15 should be played lightly and slightly separated. Balance is important through this phrase. Make sure all of the moving parts can be heard. M. 25 has a drastic change in style and dynamics, much softer and in a legato style. At m. 39 the optional whirly sound tubes are used. Students will have fun "playing" the whirly tubes, as this effect greatly adds to the eeriness of this section. Experiment with the velocity of the spin to create various pitches. You can have as many students play the whirly tubes as you wish. It works well if they are spread throughout the ensemble, and helps to prevent them from hitting each other. At m. 47, the tempo begins to accelerate to reach m.m. 120 by m. 49. Play this section as fast, yet cleanly, as possible.

I hope your students will have as much fun rehearsing and performing **Skeleton Dance** as I had writing it.
