Program Notes

Dancing In The Rain expresses the joy and childlike abandon of playing in the rain. The opening percussion groove, complete with rainstick, serves as a foundation for the simple dancing song heard throughout this African-influenced original. Tuneful countermelodies and rhythmic clapping over the African beat complete your invitation to the dance!

Rehearsal Notes

- Specific assignment of the percussion instruments is not as important as each rhythm being heard with a different timbre – feel free to reassign percussion instruments as needed based on available instruments in your band.
- Refer to a YouTube tutorial on how to play the rainstick with a continuous sound.
- Rehearse each clapping pattern (m. 52 - 59) separately and then put them together – they are the melodic rhythms presented earlier in the piece.
- Consider rehearsing all like-material in each section separately to assure everyone (melody / accompaniment / clapping) knows how their part fits into the texture at any given point.

I hope you enjoy **Dancing In The Rain**.




About the Composer






